The Lie: Recipe for Babylon

The Seduction of Religion and Politics

Who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshipped and served the creature alongside the Creator, who is blessed for the ages. Amen. ... For this cause God shall send them a strong delusion that they should believe the lie: that all they might be judged who believed not the truth, but took delight in unrighteousness (Romans 1:25; II Thessalonians 2:12).

The expression “the lie” isn’t an isolated phrase thrown into Romans and Thessalonians. “The lie” is a system of worship that has been in effect since Babel. It will reach its zenith with the coming of the man of lawlessness.



Paul’s commission restrains the lie from coming out in full force. The Body of Christ keeps the lie from reaching its ugly conclusion.

WHAT IS THE LIE?

The lie must be considered in historical context. Paul, the Apostle of the Gentiles, sets forth the truth for the Body of Christ in letters – truth for today. His Church letters begin with Romans, where the Church of God is brought onto the scene. They end with Thessalonians, where the Church is taken off the scene.

The lie is a false system of worship. The goal of religious men is to establish a brotherhood of the human race with universal peace. They want to create a paradise without God: A manmade paradise that denies the nature of death or the need of redemption from sin. They believe not the truth, but take delight in unrighteousness (II Thessalonians 2:12). In other words, they have no room for the gospel proclaimed by Paul, which reveals God’s righteousness through the faith of Christ. They don’t believe that truth. They have a works gospel, and that’s why they delight in unrighteousness. They want a universal religion and a universal government based on human merit and religion.

In Romans, Paul looks at the lie historically from its inception in Genesis 10 up until his day. In Thessalonians he shows the future development of the lie with the worship of Satan (Revelation 13). In Genesis 11 “they left off to build the city.” Man couldn’t finish his earthly paradise – God scattered them to prevent that – but the lie has been working among the individual nations ever since. Nations have their own particular religions and gods, but they all have one thing in common: salvation by human merit. Soon, though, God will allow them to finish the city that they started. The language barrier is breaking down rapidly, and the nations will soon unite.

Christendom is part of this false religion. Christendom teaches that the main goal of “the church” is to “do good” to the world, to improve our cities, and to establish a sort of Christian Socialism; to create a Christ-less millennium with world peace and united churches and religions. This is why they have become involved in international politics.

The church today is thoroughly settled down in the world. They have left Paul’s letters completely. Christendom doesn’t promote a pilgrim journey like Paul did. Instead, it promotes world establishment through religion and politics. Christians want to rule and reign here and now. These are signs of the last days – days that Paul describes as perilous. This tells us that the Body of Christ will soon be taken out of the scene. Not long after that, Babylon will be revived and dealt with.

The Christ-less churches will play a vital role in Babylon. The truth of God is no longer wanted today! The truth has been exchanged for *the lie* as it was in Genesis 10-11. The thing which hath been is that which shall be – there is nothing new under the sun (Ecclesiastes 1:9). The form of the truth may differ, but the spiritual act is identical: exchanging the truth of God for *the lie*. In Genesis 10-11 they perverted the truth revealed in creation and the testimony handed down through Noah. Today they have perverted the message of the Apostle Paul. The gospel proclaimed in churches today resembles the gospel proclaimed by Paul about as much as the Egyptian Book of the Dead represents Moses.

Warning! Note that the truth is *EXCHANGED*. That means the truth was once held. After that, it was perverted. That means we must look for *the lie* amongst those who go by the name “Christian.” In the Old Testament the name of Yahweh was mixed-up with idols. Satan’s tactics haven’t changed.

There is a revival of Egyptian religion today, and Spiritism too. The doctrines of the Book of the Dead and Spiritism are laced into the creeds and doctrinal statements of Christendom. The name of Christ and Isis have been blended in the theology of Babylon.

Where does it all lead? There will be a false Messiah

in Jerusalem and a perverted Christianity all over the earth as portrayed in Revelation 13. This is the last form of “*the lie*.”

A seductive city is going to be built on the banks of the Euphrates. Its luxuries will be unsurpassed. The whole world will admire it. Every international movement points to this one great object of man – a paradise without God, Genesis 10-11 all over again – but the end will be the same.

Christ-less Christianity along with united religions will take advantage of the decline of nationalism to promote a unified socialistic world.

Thus we are on our guard. Religious movements in particular require to be watched, as they are mostly peculiarly subtle nowadays, and it is in respect of them that Satan can put the saints to the test. It is only by the most implicit belief in God’s written Word that the many delusions of ecclesiastical systems starting up around us can be discerned in these days, and we are all first inclined to support some pet system of our own, instead of judging our own by the Word of God. We must watch them lest the conscience go astray. — E.W. Bullinger¹

A WORD OF EXHORTATION

The Lie is with us today. It affected the early Church in Paul’s day, just as it affected Israel the moment they entered the promised land! Achan coveted a Babylonian garment. So too the Church of Corinth was infected by Babylon. Paul’s letter to the Corinthians is a warning. In the first four chapters of First Corinthians we learn that the believers were being seduced by the world’s wisdom. They were professing themselves to be wise! They thought Plato and Aristotle were on a par with Solomon, David and Paul. They sought to harmonize them. They wanted the world to accept them. They wanted Christianity to find acceptance among the world’s celebrities. They wanted to make Paul’s message palatable to the world! They wanted to convert an evil eon into a good one!

Then in chapters five and six they were following the world’s commercial ways and worship. A man took

The Sabbath

On occasion I receive letters from seventh-day keepers, not exactly asking questions, but rather lecturing me on this point, and taking it for granted that I believe certain things in regard to this and other questions, which they have no means of knowing whether I believe or not, and which, as a matter of fact, I do not believe.

I will simply state my position briefly, and thus answer these.

I readily concede to our seventh-day friends that there is not the slightest authority for calling the first day the Sabbath, or keeping it as such, excepting that of the Church of Rome. I think that if there is any particular day of the week that we should keep especially holy, that day is the seventh, and not the first; but I recognize no such special obligation. What is wrong for me to do, or say, or think Saturday or Sunday, is wrong Monday, and what is right and proper Monday is equally right and proper any other day in the week.

One man esteemeth one day above another; another esteemeth every day alike. Let every man be fully persuaded in his own mind (Romans 14:5).



I'm of the number who esteem every day alike. Our apostle says,

We are not under the law but under grace (Romans 6:14).

That Paul includes the ten commandments under the general term "law" as he uses it in his epistle to the Romans is positively evident from 7:7, where he quotes one of those commandments as a sample of the teachings of the "law" about which he was talking.

The distinction that seventh-day believers make between the "Ceremonia," and the "Moral" law is convenient enough for purposes of reference, etc.; yet the Bible makes no such distinction, but includes the whole law, ceremonial and moral, under the one general name of "law."

Paul declares that the law, which was "written and engraved in stones" (i.e., the ten commandments) was the "Ministration of Death," and was to be "done away" to give place to the "Ministration of Righteousness," "which remaineth" (II Corinthians 3:7-11).


his father's wife (ch. 5), believers took other believers to court (6), and they were being seduced to partake in idolatrous rituals! First Corinthians 6 talks about eating meat, prostitution and harlots in one context. They are the enticements of Babylon! The very words "fornication" and "harlot" in the KJV are the same Greek words littered throughout Revelation, especially chapter 17, which describes Babylon. Read very carefully Numbers 25 in connection with meat, prostitution and idolatry. Isrealites were called to feasts and joined themselves to idols.

Compare also II Timothy 3:1-7 with Romans 1, and you will see that we can fall prey to this sin. It's with us today! Clinging closely to the rightly divided Scriptures while separated from the system is our only defense.

"The Church" is a huge religious business. Churches are about religion, commerce and politics. Its leaders are princes and kings promoting luxury and prosperity to their sheep. Do they suffer like Paul? Impossible. They don't have Paul's message! The "God" and "Jesus" on the lips of the common person and on the bumper-sticker of their SUV's is a non-descript deity – a deity made in the image of man. A religious fad.

Look at the churches today! False worship with the appeal of sensual surroundings, the music, the dancing, the cult-like energetic front-man (Priest, Pastor, Reverend, Apostle, etc.), the marketing, the food fellowship – all packaged in the evil cloak of religion! A soulish religion. An enticement with marketing campaigns behind them. Remember Numbers 25.

We are ripe for the one-world religion and government. Revelation 13 is just around the corner, and
