Evolution? or Creation?

It seems that man's history since the Garden of Eden has been about who's right and wrong. The debate about which position is "correct" is a strawman argument that has created much division and enmity.

Psalm 19:1 tells us,

The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork.

God isn't hiding from the rest of His creation: He's put the proof of Himself out there for *ALL* to see.

It's really quite remarkable to see evolutionists trying to deny God's existence by offering "proof" to the contrary, while creationists try to oppose evolution by offering proof of God's existence. Both seek to justify their conviction by offering opposing evidence against the other position.

Yet, God needs no one to defend him. Neither does He need anyone's help in defending His truth. His existence is not dependent on whether or not anyone believes in Him or His Word.

Most believers can see the futility of the secular evolutionistic mindset. However, Christianity's folly is that they try to figure out God, instead of just believing Him. True, Dad gave men a mind and intelligence, along with curiosity, that causes us to wonder about things; but we believers would do well to consider a few things:

FAITH IS A GIFT GIVEN BY GOD.

... by grace are you saved through faith; and that

not of yourselves: **it is the gift of God** (Ephesians 2:8).

... to you it is given in the behalf of Christ ... to believe on Him (Philippians 1:29).

No one arrives at belief in God or Jesus Christ because of their effort in researching the evidence. If anyone believes in God, it is only because Dad has given them the faith: no amount of proof, argument or effort otherwise will produce that faith. God is the One Who provides the evidence, and He's also the One Who provides the gifting of faith to individuals.

As an example of this concept, we can take Paul, the apostle for this age, as a real-life portrayal of a worst-case scenario. He was a Jew who believed in God, and had impressive credentials as a member of Israel's elite religious caste (Philippians 3:4-6). Yet he was a blasphemer (I Timothy 1:13) because he denied Jesus Christ as God's Son – in spite of the evidence – and persecuted and killed others for their belief in Him (Acts 9:1; 22:4; Galatians 1:13).

Well, then: what changed his mind? A direct intervention by the risen, glorified Lord Jesus Christ.

One may offer Hebrews 11:6 as a proof-text to the contrary, arguing that God reveals Himself to those who "work hard at seeking Him":

... he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

While we acknowledge the dispensational position that the letter to the Hebrews occupies as belonging to the eons that follow the present economy, we can also glean some general truth from this verse. Notice that faith comes first, and that faith, as we have learned from Paul, is a gift. There is a difference between "faith in" and "knowledge about" something or someone. Faith precedes knowledge; knowledge is built on the foundation of faith.

God's reward for diligent seeking is more, or greater, faith. Again, He gives us the initial faith to believe in Him; but there is further faith to be gained from being a diligent student to discover the depths of His love, His grace, *His Being* – all by the determination of His grace. Consider the following verses that relate this concept:

... God has dealt to every man the **measure of** faith (Romans 12:3).

... unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ (Ephesians 4:7).

Faith can be "increased" (II Corinthians 10:15), so not every believer believes the same things or the same way as other believers. This inequality of faith is Dad's intention, so that the Body of Christ may "... grow up" (Ephesians 4:15) and "increase ... to the edifying of itself in love" (:16), "... to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ" (:13).

Today the only people who know/believe any truth – to any degree – are those to whom Dad has revealed Himself.

A SHOCKING CONCEPT

Here is a surprising verse of which many believers are unaware, or misinformed or confused:

... the god of this world has blinded the minds of those who believe not ... (II Corinthians 4:4).

Now, consider the early chapters of Job, where we discover that Satan (the god of this world) was authorized to test Job's faith by inflicting harm and suffering on him. Who authorized his action against Job? *God*.

When Satan tempted Jesus Christ by offering to relieve Him of His suffering in the wilderness, how could he offer Him "the kingdoms of the world" if He would worship him (Matthew 4:8-9)? Because they were his to give.

When Satan entered Judas to cause him to betray the Lord Jesus Christ leading to His crucifixion, at whose behest was it? *The Lord Jesus Christ* (John 13:27). Jesus actually chose Judas for this purpose (this is the purpose for which Judas was born).

In fact, throughout the whole history of man since the beginning of creation, Satan has opposed God at every turn. This is why he is called the Adversary – the opposer, challenger, antagonist. It's his job description. God created him for this very purpose. Satan is not the result of some unforeseen circumstance for which God failed to plan. No: all of it falls under the purview of God's intentional plan for His creation.

Now, here's the "shocker," if you will: God created Satan as the instrument of His will to blind most of His creatures from knowing the truth! That's right – God is revealing Himself and His truth to only a select few (relatively speaking) during this age, and the rest are blinded by the activities of Satan and his minions:

And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness ... (II Corinthians 11:14-15).

SCIENCE IS NEUTRAL

Science in and of itself is neither "good" nor "bad": it is neutral. Rather, it is the underlying motive behind it that determines the characteristic of the conclu-

sions. As Paul warns us, we are to avoid

... profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: which some profess*ing have erred concerning the faith* (I Timothy 6:20-21).

This seems to indicate that any "science" leading to a conclusion away from God is false science - "science falsely so called." Many Christians take this warning as an application to secular scientists; but this might well be applied to Christians who have taken up the flag in support of the debate on either side of the issue. Clyde Pilkington has well stated the crux of the matter:

Even "creation scientists" are blind and follow their pre-conceived religious theories1 to influence their so-called "science." It is purely a defense of their theological doctrines, just like the evolutionist. The "evolutionist" and "young earth" scientists are of equal folly, as are the Democrats and Republicans in the arena of politics, as they are all from the same tree (Good and Evil.) It is all a masterful diversion. It is merely theologicalscience.

Christianity's folly is that they try to figure out God, instead of just believing Him. It's one thing to "diligently search" in order to come to a greater and fuller understanding of God our Father and to discover

truths about His glorious power and love. It is entirely another matter when that knowledge leads to "oppositions" that cause strife and division instead of the unity to which we are called to "endeavor to keep" (Ephesians 4:3).

A MOOT POINT

In the final analysis, the entire debate about "evolution" vs. "creation" is a total fabrication of secular philosophy that distracts believers away from God's plan and purpose for His creatures.

Debating any facet of the evolution/creation dispute



– whether arguing about man's affect on the environment, contending about the young/old earth, etc. – is really a moot point: no matter what declaration of "facts" that either side claims, as believers we need to understand that the events of our whole macro- and micro-environment are happening all at the decree of God. As Clyde Pilkington has also succinctly commented.

We are thankful to Father that we don't have to place our support or faith in the science or politics of either "side." As in all other areas, this is His story (true *his*tory), not man's.²

In reality, none of it really matters when you consider that God is going to destroy the current version of the universe and create a new version (Universe 2.0!).

And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea (Revelation 21:1).

ur believing doesn't do a thing in itself. God is the doer. God is the one who deliberately put us in problem situations and thus awakens us to faith.


God has not given us the spirit of fear (II Timothy 1:7).
