Israel's Place in God's Plan

An Introduction to Israel's Covenants and a Survey of the Abrahamic Covenant

That at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the Common-wealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world (Ephesians 2:12).

he twofold division of the Heavens and the Earth set the stage for yet another twofold division: the Body of Christ and Israel.¹

Paul tells us in Ephesians 2 that the "covenants of promise" belonged to the "Commonwealth of Israel," and that those outside of that nation were strangers to them.

Covenants are one of the more important subjects of *Jewish* Scripture. One's view of the covenants will determine one's view of the rest of Scripture, ultimately affecting one's walk as a believer.

Just what is a covenant? Covenants are *contracts* or agreements between parties. It is important for us to know *who* the parties are in the contracts of our own daily lives. It is equally as important, if not more so, for us to recognize *who* the parties of Scripture cov-

enants are. The covenants of Scripture are not made with the Body of Christ, but with the nation of Israel.

Israel's earthly calling was confirmed through a series of covenants that God made with them. These covenants were *national* in nature. Israel was chosen by God to be His *servant*-Nation on the earth:

But you, Israel, are **My servant**, Jacob³ whom I have chosen, the seed of Abraham My friend (Isaiah 41:8).

Yet now hear, O Jacob **My servant**; and Israel, whom I have chosen (Isaiah 44:1).

"Jacob," after whom the nation is named, whose name God changed to "Israel."

Remember these, O Jacob and Israel; for you are My servant: I have formed you; you are My servant: O Israel, you shall not be forgotten of Me (Isaiah 44:21).

For Jacob My servant's sake, and Israel My elect, I have even called you by your name: I have surnamed you, though you have not known Me (Isaiah 45:4).

You are **My servant**, O Israel, in whom I will be glorified (Isaiah 49:3).

NATIONAL ISRAEL

To establish a nation one must have four basic elements:

- (1) a people;
- (2) a land;
- (3) a law; and
- (4) a government.

The divine provision for these was secured by a series of four covenants that God made with Israel. Indeed, the covenants in Scripture belong to Israel:

Who are Israelites; to whom pertains ... THE **COVENANTS** ... (Romans 9:4).

ABRAHAMIC COVENANT

Israel's covenants begin with the Abrahamic Covenant, which was in fact a series of smaller covenants. These were a declaration of God's earthly purpose with Abraham and his seed, the basis and foundation for National Israel. The original covenant was

established in Genesis 12, and then confirmed and amplified in subsequent chapters.


The nature of the Abrahamic Covenants was NATION-AL. These covenants were about a NATIONAL PEOPLE with their GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES. They dealt with who the citizens of this nation were, and with their divine land-grant.

Now the LORD had said unto Abram, "Get out of your country, and from your kindred, and from your father's house, unto A LAND that I will show you: and I will make of you A GREAT NA-**TION,** and I will bless you, and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing: and I will bless them that bless you, and curse him that curses you: and in you shall all families of the earth be blessed" (Genesis 12:1-3).

And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, "Lift up now your eyes, and look from the place where you are northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: for all THE LAND which you see, to you will I give it, and to YOUR SEED for the ages (Genesis 13:14-15).

This territory was granted by covenant from "the most high God, the Possessor of heaven and earth" (Genesis 14:22). "The earth is the Lord's and the fullness thereof" (Psalm 24:1; cf. Exodus 9:29), therefore He can give it to whomever He chooses. He chose to give Israel a very specific area of land:

In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, "To your seed have I given THIS LAND, from the river of Egypt unto the

great river, the river Euphrates: the Kenites, and the Kenizzites, and the Kadmonites, and the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims, and the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Girgashites, and the Jebusites" (Genesis 15:18-21).

As God later confirmed His covenant with Abram. He changed his name to Abraham and then instituted the sign of His covenant with him: circumcision.

"And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and **YOUR SEED** after you in their generations for a covenant for the ages, to be a God unto you, and to **YOUR SEED** after you. And I will give to you, and to YOUR SEED after you, THE **LAND** wherein you are a stranger, all **THE LAND** of Canaan, as a possession for the ages; and I will be their God." And God said unto Abraham, "You will keep My covenant therefore, you, and **YOUR SEED** after you in their generations. This is My covenant, which you shall keep, between Me and you and **YOUR SEED** after you; every son among you shall be CIRCUMCISED. And you shall **CIRCUMCISE** the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant between

Me and you. And he that is eight days old shall be **CIRCUMCISED** among you, every son in your generations ... and My covenant shall be in your flesh as a covenant for the ages. And the uncircumcised son whose flesh of his foreskin is not circumcised, that soul shall be cut off from his people; he hath broken My covenant" (Genesis 17:7-14).

God confirmed the covenant that He had made with Abraham, with his son Isaac:

Sojourn in **THIS LAND**, and I will be with you and will bless you; for to you, and to YOUR SEED, I will give ALL THESE COUNTRIES, and I will perform the oath which I swore to Abraham your father; and I will make **YOUR SEED** to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give to YOUR SEED ALL THESE COUNTRIES; and in **YOUR SEED** shall all the nations of the earth be blessed (Genesis 26:3-4).

God also confirmed the covenant that He made with Abraham and Isaac with their son and grandson Jacob:

And **YOUR SEED** shall be as the dust of the earth, and you shall **SPREAD ABROAD** to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in you and in **YOUR SEED** shall all the families of the earth be blessed (Genesis 28:14).

Thus, the God of Jewish Scripture became known as the covenant *God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob*.


"I am the God of your father, THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOB." And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to look upon God. ... And God said moreover unto Moses, "Thus shall you say to the children of Israel, 'The LORD God of your fathers, THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, THE GOD OF ISAAC, AND THE GOD OF JACOb, has sent me to you'... Go, and gather the elders of Israel together, and say unto them, 'The LORD God of your fathers,

THE GOD OF ABRAHAM, OF ISAAC, AND OF JACOB ..." (Exodus 3:6, 15-16).

The final phrase of this passage – the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob – given three times in this one chapter of Exodus alone is often repeated in Scripture.

The *Abrahamic Covenant* made provision for the first two of five requirements for a nation: (1) a people, (2) a land. It also provided Israel the sign of God's covenant relation with them: *circumcision*. The remaining requirements would be secured in subsequent covenants.
