HUMAN THEORIES NEGATE THE SCRIPTURAL TEACHING OF DEATH

The plight of humanity is mortality and death. In every age the believer's hope has always been resurrection from the dead and that which lays beyond.



not negate our death beforehand. *The hope of resurrection necessitates death*. If we were to *escape* death, then that would make void God's Word regarding everyone's *appointment* with it.

It is appointed unto men once to die ...
(Hebrews 9:27).

It was Satan who first introduced the idea, "*Thou shalt not surely die.*" So, what makes anyone think that Satan was right – that we are actually not going to die? What makes someone expect that, of all of the people who have ever lived before them, they will somehow be the ones who will *escape* death?

Don't fall for the oldest trick in the Book. As long as death exists, this is simply the lot of all humanity – without exception.

"IN ADAM ALL DIE"

The answer, in one word: tradition.

The plain teaching of Scripture is that (1) death is the absence of life, and (2) that it is a sure thing for the offspring of Adam. Who shall escape death?

Our thinking has been greatly skewed by religious theories. The case in point is two-fold: the "immortality of the soul," and the "rapture." These two theories contradict the divinely revealed truth throughout Scripture of the certainty of *death and resurrection*.

The bedrock fact that "*in Adam ALL die*" is the prerequisite to the glorious truth that "*even so in Christ shall ALL be made alive*" (I Corinthians 15:22).

The living know they will die (Ecclesiastes 9:5).

As long as death reigns, one thing is sure for every individual: death. This is true for the believer *and* unbeliever alike. Regardless of when the "*appearing*" of Christ takes place in the Celestials, it will not happen without His Body, and until after every member has died and been resurrected.

ALL go to one place; ALL are of the dust, and ALL turn to dust again (Ecclesiastes 3:20; cf. 3:2; 12:7).

“TOGETHER WITH HIM”

Just like Christ our Head, every member of His Body will die. After all, we are not only united in His resurrection, but in His death and burial. We (Christ and His Body) are all in this together. He joined us in *our* death – not so that we could *escape* dying, but so that we could join Him in *His* resurrection.

One of the greatest truths of the Dispensation of Grace is that of the believer’s union “*together with Him.*” The Body of Christ is a Divine unit, prehistorically planned (Ephesians 1:4).

The Body is made up of Christ and His members. We have a shared experience: He with us, and we with Him. This shared experience is mutual – it is reciprocal – He joined us, we joined Him; Our lot became His, His lot became ours; Our history became His, His history became ours.

Christ joined us in *our* experience of suffering and death so that we could join Him in *His* experience of resurrection, Celestial ascension and exaltation. He entered into our experience so that we could enter into

His. This is more than mere identity. This is union. This is mutual involvement – *together with Him.*

So, the members of Christ’s Body actually have a *need to die, so that we can be raised.* Of a certainty Christ died; and we, too, will die. This is the process of our *union with Him.* He entered into our condition so that we could enter into His. We experience oneness with Him in suffering, death, burial, resurrection, ascension, exaltation and Celestial enthronement at God’s right hand. He did this together with us, we are doing this *together with Him.*

Dean Hough reminds us that,

When Christ died, everyone died, not at that moment in history, but proleptically.¹ Yet thus, in looking to the eventual results of the cross, we are to understand that the death of the entire old humanity is as certain as was the death of Christ Himself.²

Therefore, knowing the truth of death and resurrec-

tion, as well as the truth of the Secret Administration:

(1) Christ is *not* returning in our lifetime. The hope of His coming belongs to Israel and is precluded by Israel's abeyance and the very nature of the Secret Administration.

(2) Neither Christ's appearing nor our joint appearing with Him will take place in our lifetime. The natural law of death and resurrection precludes this. Our appearing with Him, rather than taking place *during* our *lifetime*, will take place *out from* our *death*time.

The theories of (1) being "raptured," and/or (2) being in Heaven while you are dead, are both doctrines that attempt to nullify the Scripture truth of resurrection. They are all adversarial substitutions for the biblical doctrines of death and resurrection.

Now, we can certainly understand the prevailing confusion that exists, as there are several misunderstood and misinterpreted passages that are used to uphold such no-death theories. So, we are surely sympathetic for those caught in their sway, for we too once were.

HOPE: CONFIDENT EXPECTATION? OR MISGUIDED WISH?

Within Christendom there is a skewed understanding of "hope" – especially the hope of the believer today.

When Christ, Who is our life, shall appear, then shall you also appear with Him in glory (Colossians 3:4).

One day our Head, Christ, will make His appearance in Glory;³ when He does, we, His Body, will likewise make our appearance with Him there. This will be our transformation from *death into immortality*. It will be our entrance into the ordained work for which God has already begun to prepare us during this first stage of life.

The Meaning of "Hope"

The word "hope" used in most translations does not mean "wish" as it often does in daily speech. The Greek is ἐλπίς (*elpis*) and means *a confident expectation*⁴ of that which will surely come to pass – a sure and absolute hope.⁵ It is a divine certainty. This is why the *Concordant Version* translates it as "expectation."

Our "hope" is a confident expectation of a divine reality that unquestionably will take place. However, to add a human wish-factor to it diminishes its grand power, so that it is not a "hope" at all.

The "hope" in our joint appearance with Christ is indeed something that is sure and certain to take place, because God promised it. However, if we confuse our true "hope" with some illusory idea that we will not experience death, we make our "hope" merely a "wish."

Our joint glorification at His appearing is our hope. Scripturally, our hope is not that of escaping death. Otherwise the "hope" of all of the believing dead would have been in vain, because in reality it was only a "wish" and not a truth. Let me explain further.

The Divine Guarantee

Paul was given the confident expectation of our hope today. This hope was a divine guarantee; but this came with no such pledge that Paul himself would not experience death. Escaping the personal experience of death was not a sure and certain expectation of his greater revelation.

Consequently, if any believer during the past 2,000 years had confused their hope with *not* experiencing death, then surely they would have “hoped” in vain – and vanity is not a part of faith.

Exchanging a scriptural “*hope*” for a “*wish*” to evade death tends toward distraction, disappointment, disillusionment and depression, instead of joy, happiness, contentment and peace. This often has been the experience of those who have confused such a “*wish*” for divine certainty.

However, when we realize that “*in Adam ALL die*” then we can remain genuinely steadfast day-by-day through the trials of life, even until death.

Be sure to grasp the serious and crucial distinction. Our “*wishing*” for something, regardless of how sincere and earnest we may be, simply will not make it so – nor will it make it the truth of Scripture.

Never let anyone take away the object of our “*hope*” and substitute it for some ill-founded “*wish*.” Our peace and joy are *NOT* dependent on the avoidance of death, but on our resurrection and appearance “*together with Him*.” In spite of death, our confident expectation, our sure and certain destiny, is to join Him in His appearance in Glory!

Thankfully, we can make a relative application of these truths to our own lives. I often remember some very precious words from A.E. Knoch that I will adapt here for us:

In actual practice our appearing with Christ is not relatively a far-off future meeting, with long centuries of waiting in between. To our consciousness it comes immediately at the close of life. To be sure, the Lord does not appear at the decease of His saints; but to those who die it will seem just as if He has. To a sleeper, the morning immediately follows the evening. The night is nothing. To each one the moment of death will seem the moment of rousing.⁶


TESTIMONIES CONCERNING THE CERTAINTY OF DEATH

We will now share some excerpts concerning the theme of death from valued and trusted authors. These men were not immune to the effects of contradictory theories. While they all may have “*wished*” for an escape from death, they all nevertheless died. Their *supposed* “*hope*” of bypassing death was certainly not a divine certainty; quite the contrary, it was death that was the divine certainty. However sincere, their *supposed* “*hope*” was actually nothing more than a mere “*wish*.” Regardless of their theories that conflicted with Scripture, note their amazing words concerning death’s certainty.

Joseph E. Kirk (1903-1974)

“*As in Adam all die.*” Death is the heritage of all who are related to Adam, none escape it. Even those who believe in Jesus Christ as their Savior

succumb to the sleep of death and are referred to as “*the dead in Christ*” (I Thessalonians 4:13-18); and as “*the dead*” that “*shall be raised incorruptible*” (I Corinthians 15:51-52). The fact that “*those who are Christ’s*” need to be “*made alive at His coming*” shows that they too are included in the ALL who die in Adam.

Satan’s success in blinding men to the nature and extent of death is the cause of much error. That this would be a master stroke of deception is evidenced by the fact that Satan’s first lie was “*Ye shall not surely die*” (Genesis 3:4). This deception is still believed by many in spite of the fact that all die. Truth is sometimes rejected because it is unpleasant. The apparent finality of death appalls man. His aversion to death causes him to welcome any philosophy that explains it away. To reject the truth concerning death is to lose the comfort contained in God’s way of dealing with it. Death is indeed a grim and relentless enemy, but there is One Who is “*the Resurrection and the Life*” (John 11:25). He has “*the keys of death and of Hades*” (Revelation 1:17-18). He it is Who will conquer death and set its victims free. ... Adam’s one offense brought judgment to all men to their condemnation. None escape this condemnation to death.⁷

A.E. Knoch (1874-1965)

The universality of death, through Adam, is beyond question.⁸

Death is insisted on everywhere as being the lot, not only of humanity, but of other creatures as well.

At the very forefront of revelation man is denied immortality. The serpent had indeed said, “*Ye shall not surely die*” (Genesis 3:4). ...

How anyone, in the face of the narrative, coupled with the distinct assertion that Christ alone has immortality (I Timothy 6:16) – how anyone can still believe Satan’s lie, seems almost incredible. Yet we know that those in high places not only

hold and herald it forth as truth, but seek to find “*evidence*” for it in the Scriptures!⁹

The fact that the believer and the unbeliever share alike in the first death ought to be sufficient proof that it is not, in any sense, a judicial infliction on God’s part. The saint is assured of immunity from all judgment yet he does not escape the first death.¹⁰

George L. Rogers (1869-1947)

The certainty of the reign of death is brought home to us continually. The Spirit of God uses the fact to prove the greater certainty that grace will confer righteousness, peace, life and exaltation to lordship. The present reign of death is an order so firmly established that revolt against it would be useless. That this tyrannous reign rests on the comparatively slight foundation of the single sin of a single sinner serves as a measure by which to establish the certainty of the reign in life. By dying, each individual yields compulsory tribute to the sovereignty of death. ...

Is it not true that though the Savior has appeared He has not released any from condemnation to death? His people accept the penalty as just, and they die with the confidence that resurrection of life is as certain as the condemnation to death. ... The condemnatory sentence of God cannot be reversed.

In our present text¹¹ are two divine sentences pronounced on the race – the condemnation and the just award, *dikaiooma*.¹² The latter does not annul the former or reprieve anyone from condemnation to death. Nor does the universal condemnation, nor the other condemnatory sentences that will be pronounced, annul the *dikaiooma*. All God’s judicial sentences whether condemnatory or justificatory are irreversible and will be fully executed. Justification will come after every adverse sentence has been executed.¹³

“A Thousand Generations”

Multiplied millennia remain, more than have yet transpired, for the fulfillment of all of the glorious plans of the ages that God has revealed in His Word.

Far from us being anywhere near the “end” of something prophetic, the span of God’s eonian plan is immense, and our placement in the Secret Administration is early on its timeline. Much more of God’s prophetic program remains than man’s feeble eschatologies allow.

Carefully notice God’s specific promise of “a thousand generations” in the following verses:

Showing faithful love to a thousand generations of those who love Me and keep My commands (Exodus 20:6, HCSB).

Keeping lovingkindness to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin ... (Exodus 34:7, YLT).

Showing lovingkindness unto a thousand generations unto them who love Me, and keep My commandments (Deuteronomy 5:10, REB).

Know therefore that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations

(Deuteronomy 7:9).

Be mindful always of His covenant; the word which He commanded to a thousand generations (I Chronicles 16:15).

He has remembered, unto times age-abiding, His covenant, the word He commanded, to a thousand generations (Psalm 105:8, REB).

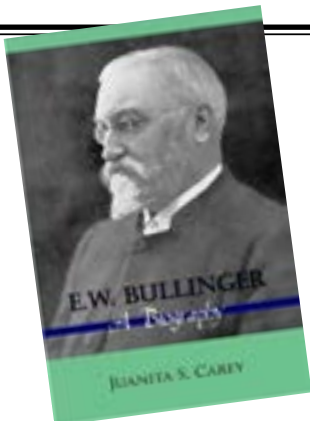
Thou exercise kindness unto the thousandth generation ... (Jeremiah 32:18, Leeser Translation, 1853).

A generational cycle is the period from the birth of one generation to the birth of the next. If the lower end of a generational cycle were 20 years,¹ God’s prophetic fulfillment with Israel would be 20,000 years. However, if it would be on the higher end of the scale, this period would be upwards of some 50,000 years.²

It is essential for us to understand that Israel’s unfulfilled prophecies will be brought to pass over a *very long period* of time – at least 20,000 years, or possibly more.

Even considering the most conservative period of

20,000 years, here is a breakdown of the remainder of the ages:

Phase 1:

The Pre-Millennial Kingdom

Perhaps encompassing some 500 years or more.

Phase 2:

The Millennial Kingdom

1000 years.

Phase 3

The New Earth Kingdom

18,500 years or more.

While some start this thousand-generation fulfillment with Adam³ or Abraham,⁴ others⁵ (such as ourselves) see that this entire period of promise more likely remains to be yet future.

So, once the Secret Administration has run its Divinely designated course, as much as 50,000 prophetic years remain.

However, regardless of the actual duration, here is what some diligent students of the Scriptures have written concerning these many prophetic millennia yet to be fulfilled.

GEORGE L. ROGERS (1869-1947)

Many generations are yet to come. Israel's future place in the new earth is indicated by the fact that God's covenant with them is to a thousand generations.

We find in Deuteronomy 7:9 and I Chronicles 16:15 an indirect, but not unimportant, confirmation of our forecast, where the duration of the covenant of God with Israel is extended, not merely to a thousand years, but to "a thousand generations" – a truly glorious revelation of Israel's future in the Age of the new creation ...

How many generations will there be? Some idea of the number will enable us to form a rough estimate of its length. The psalmist speaks of a thousand generations (Psalm 105:8). I know of no good reason why this should not be taken literally.

The length of a generation is not easy to determine, neither is it vital. It could hardly average under twenty years. ...

I have sometimes wondered if the eons are measured by that long astronomical cycle of nearly twenty-six thousand years which is formed by the sun as it shifts its place in crossing the ecliptic, making what is called the precession of the equinoxes. At one time the sun's annual crossing of the ecliptic in the spring of the year, making day and night of equal length, occurred in the sign of Virgo. Now it is in Aries. At the end of the cycle it will be in Leo. It leads from the

Virgin to the Lion out of Judah's tribe. All of the symbolism seems to fit this notion. Even the thousand generations may find a place in this speculation. I do not rely upon it. But these figures leave little doubt that the last eon will be an enormously prolonged period of time. ...

The point we wish to press is this, that by far the greater part of mankind in the eons are found in the last of the series.
