Bible Basics #4

The Two Realms

In the beginning God created the **Heavens** and the **Earth** (Genesis 1:1).

With the very first verse of Scripture we are immediately introduced to the two realms of God's Universe:

"the Heavens and the Earth."

God has a definite plan and purpose related to these two distinct cosmographic realms.

God has a unique plan for the Earth, which will find its fulfillment in National Israel. It is their destiny to have earthly (*i.e.*, terrestrial) dominion – to establish God's divine order of authority on the Earth.

God also has a specific plan for the Heavens which will find its fulfillment in the Body of Christ. Our destiny is in the Heavens – the Celestial dominion – to establish God's divine order of authority in the Heavens.

However, after God revealed the two realms in Genesis 1:1, He then immediately begins a revelation of His plan for "the Earth," for in the next verse we read,

And the Earth ... (:2).

This *emphasis* on "the Earth" occupies the focus of divine revelation for the next four thousand years.



The Old Testament¹ is the story of "the Earth."² The Hebrew word for "Earth" (אֶרֶץ, *erets*) is found 20 times in Genesis chapter 1 alone, and 2505 times in Genesis through Malachi. The Earth is the theme of the Hebrew Scriptures and most of the Greek Scriptures.

O Earth, Earth, Earth, hear the Word of the LORD (Jeremiah 22:29).

Israel is the divinely chosen vessel of God's *earthly* realm. It is not until we get to "the Administration of the Secret" (Ephesians 3:9, CV), revealed through Paul in Ephesians and Colossians, that God unveils His majestic plan and purpose regarding *the Heavens*, which then becomes the *focus*, rather than *the Earth*. The One Body is the divinely chosen vessel for God's realm in the Heavens.

However, before we can clearly understand and appreciate God's grand plan for the Heavens and *our*

1. The use of the term "Old Testament" as a reference to the books of the Hebrew Scriptures is actually a misnomer. The term "old testament" is a reference to an earlier (Mosaic) covenant that God has made with Israel which was made "old" because it was displaced by a "new covenant" also made with them. "In that He said, 'A new covenant,' He has made the first old" (Hebrews 8:13).
2. This is not to say that the Hebrew Scriptures never mention "the Heavens," for of course, as we have pointed out, the very first verse in Genesis does. The point being made here is that "the Earth," and not "the Heavens," is the *theme* of Hebrew Scriptures.

unique place in it, we must first recognize His extensive plan for *Israel and the Earth*.

Restricting ourselves to the book of Genesis alone, let's give utmost consideration and care to the following passages as they relate to *the Earth*:

*And God said, "Let us make man in Our image, after Our likeness: and let them have **dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and **over all THE EARTH**, and over every creeping thing that creeps upon **THE EARTH**." ... And God said unto them, "Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish **THE EARTH**, and **subdue** it: and have **dominion** over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moves upon **THE EARTH**" (Genesis 1:26-28).*

*And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, "Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish **THE EARTH**. And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the Earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all*

*that moves **upon THE EARTH**, and upon all the fish of the sea; into your hand are they delivered" (Genesis 9:1-2).*

*Now the LORD had said unto Abram, "Get out of your country, and from your kindred, and from your father's house, unto a land that I will show you: and I will make of you a great **nation**, and I will bless you, and make your name great; and you will be a blessing: and I will bless them that bless you, and curse him that curses you: and in you will all families of **THE EARTH** be blessed" (Genesis 12:1-3).*

*And the LORD said unto Abram, after that Lot was separated from him, "Lift up now your eyes, and look from the place where you are northward, and southward, and eastward, and westward: for all **THE LAND** which you see, to you will I give it, and to your seed for the ages" (Genesis 13:14-15).*

*And in your seed shall **all the nations of THE EARTH be blessed**; because you have obeyed My voice (Genesis 22:18).*

And your seed shall be as **the dust of THE EARTH**, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in you and in your seed will **all the families of THE EARTH** be blessed (Genesis 28:14).

As we can plainly see from these passages, *the Earth* and its dominion are the theme. Abraham and his descendants (Israel) became the recipients of this *earthly* focus; their destiny and expectation clearly being a *literal, physical, earthly kingdom*. Not just any kingdom, however, but it is an Abrahamic and Davidic Kingdom that is the underlying and predominant theme of the Jewish Scriptures.

Peter understood this theme. In Matthew 19 Jesus confirmed this expectation when replying to Peter's inquiry:

We have forsaken all, and followed You. What shall we have therefore?

Peter was expecting something related to an earthly kingdom, and he will not be disappointed – the Lord Jesus Christ Himself said so!

Christ was “a minister of the Circumcision” Who had come “to **confirm** the promises made to the Fathers.”

Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the Circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made to the Fathers (Romans 15:8).

Recognize the significance of this truth: *Christ was a*

minister to the CIRCUMCISION.

Even after the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ, Peter rightfully voiced Israel's prophetic earthly expectation.


Lord, will You at this time restore again the Kingdom to Israel? (Acts 1:6).

How very few today know that our Lord's teaching ministry while on *Earth* was to *confirm* the prophetic promises of Hebrew Scripture concerning Israel's *earthly* destiny?

Most mistakenly believe that *Israel's* Messiah came to teach something “new,” when in fact His teaching was centered on the former promises made to Israel's Forefathers. His response to Peter's question was no exception!

Verily I say to you, that you who have followed Me in the regeneration, when the Son of Man shall sit on the throne of His glory, you also shall sit on Twelve Thrones, judging the Twelve Tribes of Israel. And every one who has forsaken houses, or brothers, or sisters, or father, or mother, or wife, or children, or lands for My name's sake, shall receive a hundred-fold, and shall inherit age-lasting life. But many who are first shall be last, and the last shall be first (Matthew 19:28-30).

Jesus Christ confirmed to Peter the *prophetic* promises made to Israel's Fathers. When the Lord sets up His *literal, physical, earthly, Abrahamic, Davidic* Kingdom in Jerusalem, the Twelve Apostles will indeed sit on Twelve Thrones, ruling the Twelve Tribes

of Israel. All that they had *physically* forsaken for their Messiah will be restored to them *physically* a hundred-fold.

The *Earth* is Israel's destiny.

ARROGANCE

Christendom is extremely self-centered. It seems to think that all of Scripture is somehow just about "them." Even though it is surely true that "***all Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable***" (II Timothy 3:16), it must be *rightly divided* (2:15).

We hear the arrogance of Christianity in such audacious statements as, "All of the promises in the Bible are mine!" Yet all of the promises in the Bible *do NOT* belong to any one group of people. Again, while all of the Bible is certainly FOR us, it is not all TO us or ABOUT us.

Many today remain caught up in a mindset that wants all of the truth of Scripture to be directed to them. With such conceit many have been carried away, pilfering that which belongs to others. They embrace a manmade theology espousing that God's dealings with Israel are permanently over, and that somehow they themselves have managed to take ownership of her promises and destiny, and as a result have by some means managed to become "Spiritual-Israel."

Paul warned against such self-centered conceit that does not recognize Israel's future place in God's plan

and disregards the vital truth of "*rightly dividing the Word of Truth*" (II Timothy 2:15).

For I would not, brothers, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fullness of the Gentiles be come in (Romans 11:25).

God clearly is *not* done with Israel. Their having been set aside is only "*until the fullness of the Gentiles*" is accomplished. Paul cautioned against being ignorant of the mystery that was revealed to him and being "*wise in our own conceits.*"

THE SACRED SECRET

Paul was the apostle of the Heavens, commissioned from Heaven, concerning Heaven. The *Secret Administration* revealed and committed to Paul made known the realm of Heaven in a way previously unknown before (Ephesians 3:1-11; 1:4-9; Colossians 1:24-27). His is "*a dispensation of the grace of God*" (Ephesians 3:2, 9; Colossians 1:25), dealing with the agents of Heaven: *The One Body* (Ephesians 2:16; 4:4; Colossians 3:15). By contrast, the dispensation of law was committed to Moses, which dealt with Israel and God's *earthly* realm.

It is critical to recognize these two major divine plans. Nothing but confusion can arise from reading into one realm that which relates to another. As the law of Moses was authoritative over Israel, so the

pinnacle of Paul's revelation found in Ephesians and Colossians is equally authoritative over us today.

One must not confuse the *prophecy* related to Israel and God's plan in the Earth with the *Secret Administration* related to us and God's plan in the Heavens. Neither should this secret be confused with the secrets related to the Kingdom of Heaven (Matthew 13:11). God's secret plan of the Heavens is a glorious message *distinct* from that of Israel's and the Twelve Apostles'.

PAUL'S UNIQUE USAGE OF "HEAVEN" (AND "HEAVEN AND EARTH")

Thus, Paul, the apostle who had been "caught away unto **the third HEAVEN**" (II Corinthians 12:2, YLT)³ made use of the word "Heaven" in a way never before revealed in the Scriptures. Here is a concordance of his usage of the word "Heaven" in Ephesians and Colossians.

*Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who has blessed us with all spiritual blessings **in HEAVENLY places** in Christ* (Ephesians 1:3).

That in the dispensation of the fullness of times He might gather together in one all things in

*Christ, **both which are in HEAVEN**, and which are on EARTH; even in Him* (Ephesians 1:10).

*Which He wrought in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead, and set Him at His Own right hand **in the HEAVENLY places*** (Ephesians 1:20).

*And has raised us up together, and made us sit together **in HEAVENLY places** in Christ Jesus* (Ephesians 2:6).

*To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers **in HEAVENLY places** might be known by the church [ecclesia] the manifold wisdom of God* (Ephesians 3:10)


*Of Whom the whole family **in HEAVEN and EARTH** is named* (Ephesians 3:15).

*He Who descended is the same also Who ascended up far **above all HEAVENS**, that He might fill all things* (Ephesians 4:10)

*For the hope which is laid up for you **in HEAVEN*** (Colossians 1:5).

PRESENT TRUTH WAS NEVER THE SUBJECT OF PROPHECY

The foremost fundamental of present truth¹ is that the “Dispensation of the Grace of God” is a parenthetic era. By this, I mean that this dispensation² is as if it were placed within a parenthesis in the Chart of the Ages. It was unprophesied, having been hidden in the heart of God since before the overthrow of the World.



whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the Mystery of Christ); Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is **now** revealed unto His holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit (Ephesians 3:4-5).

The current Dispensation of Grace was hidden in the Heart of God and was never made known in other ages or dispensations. It had been God's Secret which He shared with no one.

And to make all men see what is the Dispensation of the Mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, Who created all things by Jesus Christ (Ephesians 3:9).

*Whereof I am made a minister, according to the Dispensation of God which is given me for you, to fulfil [i.e., to complete] the Word of God. Even the Mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but **now** is made manifest to His saints (Colossians 1:25-26).*

How that by revelation He made known unto me the Mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

Not a single prophecy of the Old Testament was directed to the Grace Dispensation. None of the prophetic Scriptures knew anything about the Dispensation of the Mystery. Present Truth for today was only revealed by Paul and was not the subject of any prophecy.

The truth of the Mystery is not associated with the Second Coming of Christ – the *Parousia* – but looks for the glorious Appearing of Christ (Colossians 3).

PRESENT TRUTH IS A DISPENSATION OF GOD'S SILENCE

When did the Dispensation of God's Grace begin? It began after Paul spent “two whole years in his own hired house” (Acts 28:30) when the Acts of the Apostles came to an end.

1. [Editor:] “Present truth” was a term used by Peter to refer to the truth which he ministered to Israel (II Peter 1:12). This term has dispensational bearings. Our “present truth” today is found in Paul's epistles of the Secret Administration: Ephesians and Colossians.

In Acts 28:25-28, the Apostle Paul pronounced blindness upon Israel. With this profound pronouncement, God set Israel aside and ceased dealing with them. All promises that God made to the fathers of Israel which have not been fulfilled before the close of the Acts Period are now held in abeyance. They are awaiting the coming Day of Christ, or Day of the Lord, or the Day of God to be fulfilled.

The Lord Jesus revealed to Paul the most profound revelation ever made known to man. The stupendous revelation of Christ Jesus being (1) the Head over all things to a new calling – the Church, over which He is the Head, (2) it is also revealed that He is the Head over all of Heaven's hierarchy, namely, the Principalities, Powers, Might, Dominions, and every name that is named (Ephesians 1:21; Colossians 1:16), (3) and that believers today are ranked "far above" all of Heaven's hierarchy, (4) in this new calling, there is no longer "Gentile nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all" (Colossians 3:10), and (5) this new calling is not likened to a Bride, but rather as "one New Man" (Ephesians 2:15).

Present Truth for today is to be recognized as being the exclusive revelation of truth made known to Paul while he was a Prisoner of Jesus Christ when the Pentecostal Dispensation ended.

In past ages and dispensations, God spoke audibly to the world, or to special groups, or to select individuals. Today, He speaks to believers through His completed written Word – the height of which are the truths for the current *Dispensation of the Grace of God*.

PRESENT TRUTH IS A DISPENSATION OF GRACE

*If ye have heard of the **dispensation of the grace of God** which is given me to you-ward (Ephesians 3:2).*

During this dispensation God dispenses only grace. He doesn't dispense signs, wonders, and miracles in today's economy; He doesn't dispense Spiritual Gifts; He doesn't punish.

All miraculous things were withdrawn with the

setting aside of Israel at the close of the Acts of the Apostles which ended the Pentecostal Dispensation.

A PRAYER FOR ENLIGHTENMENT

The revelation of the Mystery becomes manifest to the heart of a believer only by the means of Divine enlightenment.

*That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him: **the eyes of your understanding being enlightened**; that ye may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints (Ephesians 1:17-18). **BSN***

Evaluating Western Christianity's Interpretation of Biblical Polygamy

This book demonstrates that the popular Western worldview regarding marriage affects biblical interpretation. While most Western societies uphold monogamy as God's ideal form of marriage, a number of other cultures practice polygamy. Western Christianity often perceives polygamy as a threat to the monogamist ideal; therefore, this book evaluates whether the Bible clearly advocates that polygamous men should become monogamous through divorce.

After interpreting Scripture through the lens of the biblical audience, this book then applies the interpretations from the five biblical texts to a modern situation involving polygamy. Since there is no biblical text that explicitly prohibits polygamy or promotes monogamy, this book argues that the interpretation of the monogamist ideal tends to derive from one's worldview rather than the Bible.

Thus, the very first verse of Scripture gives us these two realms of God's universe.

In the beginning God created the Heavens and the Earth (Genesis 1:1).

It is vital that we know the place given to us by God today – a position and expectation

... *far above all Heavens* (Ephesians 4:10).

Note that it is not just “*in the Heavens*” (ἐν τοῖς οὐρανοῖς), but “*far above all Heavens*” (ὑπεράνω πάντων τῶν οὐρανῶν), or,

“*over-above all the Heavens*” (REB);

“*up beyond the highest Heavens*” (TCNT).

It is from here, up in the *Super-Heaven*, that we have the best vantage point, divinely granted, for us to view all of life and its array of circumstances. It allows us to see the divine perspective in all things.

In the End these same two realms, all the way back from the beginning, both “*the Heavens and Earth*,” will be consummated back to God, that He may be “*All in all*.”

By Him [Christ] to reconcile all things to Himself; by Him, I say, whether they are things in Earth, or things in Heaven (Colossians 1:20).

For out of Him, and through Him, and to Him, are ALL (Romans 11:36).

That God may be ALL in all (I Corinthians 15:28).

In the meantime, we listen closely to Paul's instruction,

Since then you have been raised with Christ, aim at what is above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; mind what is above, not what is on Earth, for you died and your life is hidden with Christ in God. When Christ, Who is our life, appears, then you will appear with Him in Glory (Colossians 3:1-4, Moffatt) **BSN**



Two gifts given to the believer are mentioned by Paul in Philippians 1:29. The first is “to believe on Him.” This is a glorious gift. Every believer has been given this gift from God.
