“Behold Your Calling, Brethren”

NOT MANY

Behold your calling, brethren, that **NOT MANY** wise after the flesh, **NOT MANY mighty**, **NOT MANY noble** (I Corinthians 1:26.)



– where are they? A few here and a few there *are* called, but “not many.”

But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty (I Corinthians 1:27).

“Not many”: Look around; there is only a little handful of us, comparatively.

NOT MANY WISE

“Not many wise”: God does not select many “big-brained people,” “scientists” – the so-called “great ones,” loaded with “degrees.” We often wish we had “the wise” with us. We say, “If only So-and-so were among us!” Well, if they were, they would perhaps be a great nuisance. God *chooses* the foolish things.

Not many wise after the flesh.

What I am after is to get you to believe your calling. “Behold your calling!” Would you want a great number of “wise” people? Some say, “Yes, that would dignify us.” However, those who are in Christ *are* wise, and wise with a wisdom conferred on them by God.

NOT MANY MIGHTY

Next we find, “not many **mighty**” are called. Not many great statesmen, nor influential captains of industry, nor wizards of finance. Well, now, that’s too bad! “We need men of influence and stability,” I hear someone say. How about these Galilean fishermen, then? Shall we let them in? Have they much influence, great fame? “No.” The great men of the world

Oh, the strength of *men*, these days! These are days of the Gentiles. *God* has given them their greatness. This is “*Man’s Day*,” you know (see I Corinthians 4:3, RV, marg.). Many great men “go to church” because it is proper, because it is a good thing for them politically. Also, they have a conscience, so they salve it by wearing a fine suit and shined shoes, and “going to church”; but God says, “*not many mighty*.”

NOT MANY NOBLE

Next, “not many *noble*” are called. You wish we had some with “Honorable” in front of their names, or letters after them? God says He chose the “*weak*” things, and you and I must surrender to God’s way. The real, lowly saints of God are held in contempt by some, but in that day when all of the saints join Christ in reigning, the mighty man will be brought low:

The lofty looks of man shall be brought low, and

the haughtiness of men shall be brought down,
and Jehovah alone shall be exalted in that day
(Isaiah 2:11).

It is a long, long march for the saints, but it is coming.

God has chosen the “weak” things. Are you willing to be in a calling where God has chosen the weak things? Weak-minded as over against the strong-minded, the mighty?

“Not many noble” are called. Do you surrender to that? Lady Huntingdon of England, who built chapels for the Wesleys to use, was one of that “not many noble” class, and she said she was “called” on the letter “m.” She said, “If God had said ‘not **any** noble,’ I would have been omitted. Thank God for that letter ‘m!’”

Our Lord got the [reputation] of being “a friend of publicans and sinners,” and all kinds of humble and low-born (as the world would call them), uneducated, slum folks. There were “not many noble.”

But God hath chosen ... the **base** things ... the

things which are **despised** ... and things which are **not** [the zero things!] to bring to nought the things that are: that **no flesh** should glory in His presence” (I Corinthians 1 :28-29).





"To Will and to Do"

[To D.R.:] Yes, indeed, you are COMPLETELY justified! 100%! As for Divine judgment – it is remedial. It is not "punishment," but rather it is "justice" – *setting things right*. "Judgment" brings justice. Even death is simply the end of the dying process ("*to die shall you be dying*," Genesis 2:17, CV). Without the planting of the seed there would be no resurrection.¹

Yes, I was very confused and conflicted when I left legalistic Christianity. All I ever knew was the performance of a list of "dos" and "don'ts," never truly realizing that it was all "done" in Christ. The law is not a reflection of God's character, but of man's. It was given to Israel (Exodus 20:20) as a "litmus test," one that they utterly failed by design (Romans 3:20).

Christianity is a *religion* – just like all the rest – of "do." Listen to your typical Christian sermon and you will hear all about what you should "do." Christianity is firmly a performance-based religion. However, the clear truth of our gospel is, "done!" Many years ago W. Leon Tucker (1871-1934) capably wrote of the contrast between religion's process of "do," and God's accomplishment of "done."

"Do," "Do," we hear on every hand, and how seldom do we hear "Done." Thank God, in a world of so many unfinished things there is one thing finished. "*It is finished*" – the work of the Savior is finished, said He Who did it, and no one yet has ever been able to point out an unfinished thing in that redemption work ...

The "done" takes away the "do." "Do" means human endeavor, "Done" means Divine accomplishment. "Do" is possible to man, "Done" is alone possible with God. "Do" satisfies the flesh, "Done" is grasped by faith. "Do" is the exercise of human energy, "Done" is the display of the Divine initiative.

There is no rest in man's "do." There is complete and lasting rest in God's "done." Religion is about highlighting and bragging on man and his accomplish-

ments. We highlight and brag on God and His accomplishments through Christ. What a contrast. Rest in the completed work of the Lord Jesus Christ. This alone is the true basis of our gospel.

You are complete in Him (Colossians 2:10).²

As for what God would want us to live like, you are correct that He desires us to walk in love, grace, mercy, forbearance and forgiveness.

Put on, then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, pitiful compassions, kindness, humility, meekness, patience, bearing with one another and dealing graciously among yourselves, if anyone should be having a complaint against any. According as the Lord also deals graciously with you, thus also you. Now over all these put on love, which is the tie of maturity. And let the peace of Christ be arbitrating in your hearts, for which you were called also in one body; and become thankful (Colossians 3:12-15).

As for the particulars, it is vital in the progress from law to grace to embrace two principle found in Philippians:

Being confident of this very thing, that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ (1:6) [or]

Having this same confidence, that He Who undertakes a good work among you, will be performing it until the day of Jesus Christ (CV).

For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of His good pleasure (2:13) [or]

For it is God Who is operating in you to will as well as to work for the sake of His delight (CV).

Your life is not yours; it is God's. You belong to Him, you are His workmanship/achievement (Ephesians 2:10). He began the work in you, and He will perform it to completion. He does so by working/operating His good pleasure/delight in you. He first gives you the *desire* ("to will") and then the *ability* ("to do"/"to work") to do His

pleasure/delight. It really is just as simple as that. This is true spirituality: the operation of God's spirit producing fruit in our lives. This is not about a list of "dos" and "don'ts." It is about divine life manifesting itself in us. It is just relaxing – and resting in His life in us.

God is at work in you, – He works in you to "will" – to *want to* – and then He also works in you the "do" – the ability to do His good pleasure. What a wonderful truth! He is accomplishing two things:

- (1) He is putting His "will" in you – your *want to*; and,
- (2) He is working the "do" in you as well – the ability to "do" what He has put on your heart (the "will").

Allow this astonishing truth to get ahold of you! This is God's work in your life in a nutshell – "to will and to do." Father is working something into you ("For it is God Who works in you"); He is working into you His Own will ("to will"), putting His own "want to" in you.

Someone may ask, "Can't your heart lead you astray?" Surely, it can; but not while it is set on the Lord and the things that are above.

Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth. For you are dead, and your life is

hid with Christ in God (Colossians 3:2-3).

While you look to Him, setting your affection there, your Father places in you your heart's desires. Belonging to Him, you are given a willing heart for the details of His life and purpose, making you His very vessel. Trust and acknowledge the in-working of His will. Keep your focus on Him and then, follow your heart! You thus honor God and His design by being you.

What you express to me in your correspondence is the spirit of God breaking free from the bondage of law, human effort, and religious tradition.

For freedom Christ frees us! Stand firm, then, and be not again enthralled with the yoke of slavery (Galatians 5:1) **BSN**

My name is James, and I am a “Heretic”!

I was a member of that little Baptist church for 8 months about 3 years ago. When I left, I told the 68-year-old pastor what I really believed. You know, salvation of all, no hell, and no Trinity. Until I said, “no Trinity,” he said, “well that doesn’t matter.” But when I said “no Trinity,” he said “Then you are not saved.”



churches goes back to the Westminster Confession of Faith and Larger and Shorter Catechisms. This is a 217-page document; so, I started with a smaller one that most Baptist churches might use. I read the 1689 Baptist Confession of Faith which is only 46 pages.

I have stayed in touch with him on Facebook because he is a great guy, and we didn’t argue over doctrine at all. But recently he started to chime in on my Facebook posts. Most of my posts are re-postings of *Daily Email Goodies*. His true colors started to come out then. I would not argue with him, but I would send a PDF of a *Bible Student’s Notebook* article that explained my position and answered his question. But he would not read it. He said, “I know all I care to know about what you believe.” I asked him, “So you fear for my soul, right?” and he said, “I do.”

Out of the 32 points, I disagree strongly with 23 points, and I had problems with 8 points. The only point I didn’t have problems with was the one about *Sola Scriptura* which means that Scripture alone is authoritative for faith and practice.

At that point I started to research if anything else that Christendom believed would make one a “Heretic” and exclude one from eternal salvation. I found out that if you disagree with even one point in Christendom’s Creeds or Confessions you are not saved and are a “Heretic.”

That being said, I suffer from religious temptation. That is, the temptation to participate in organized Christianity. The draw is great. I live in a town where there are no others who believe what I believe about Scripture. I personally know only one person in another town that I ever see and fellowship with that believes what I believe. So, it’s a lonely walk. That is why I was led into an 8-month tour of duty in that little Baptist Church 3 years ago. It’s tempting to be able to say the name “God” or “Jesus” out loud and not be looked at like I said a dirty word. I work with many 20 something atheists and you do not ever mention God or the Bible around them or they will go to HR. It’s also nice to get hit with the “love bomb” each Sunday.

I discovered that the main creed of Protestant
