“Fear and Trembling”

Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with **fear and trembling**, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ (Ephesians 6:5).

Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with **fear and trembling** (Philippians 2:12).

“**F**ear and trembling” (φόβος καὶ τρόμος, *phobos kai tromos*) is a figure of speech, an idiom, in particular a Hebraism, meaning a humble “honor and respect,” or “reverence and awe.”



In *figures of speech* individual words do not carry their regular meanings. Rather, as oddly as it may seem at first, they express some *different* idea. An *idiom* is defined as:

A group of words established by usage as having a meaning not deducible from those of the individual words.¹

We have countless idioms in the English language. Here are a few examples:

- ◆ “raining cats and dogs”
- ◆ “cold feet”
- ◆ “hit the hay”
- ◆ “under the weather”
- ◆ “up in the air”

- ◆ “stabbed in the back”
- ◆ “spill the beans”
- ◆ “costs an arm and a leg”
- ◆ “it’s a piece of cake”
- ◆ “the ball’s in your court”
- ◆ “takes two to tango”

- ◆ “pulling my leg”
- ◆ “sitting on the fence”
- ◆ “through thick and thin”
- ◆ “once in a blue moon”

As we can see, an idiom may not merely carry a meaning *different* from the normal sense of the individual words, but even a significance that is quite the *opposite*. For example, if we were to say to someone, “Break a leg!,” would you be wishing them *ill will* or

good? The words taken individually, as to their literal meaning, would be wishing ill will upon someone. Thus, the phrase would be a curse of evil. However, based on the English idiom, our intent actually would be the exact opposite: we would be wishing, instead of a curse, blessing upon them – the very best of success!

It is such idioms that make learning a new language difficult. Someone learning English and taking such phrases literally are at a complete loss. These figures of speech are so very odd to them. Of course, the same problem presents itself with the language of Scripture.²

Literal versions of Scripture *must* translate an idiom (or any other figure of speech), word-for-word, exactly *as it is*, and leave their interpretation to teachers. However, other versions – like those following “Dynamic Equivalent” or “Free Transla-

tion” styles – are able to convey the meaning of the idioms.

An example of the latter, in regard to “*fear and trembling*,” are both Williams³ and Goodspeed⁴ rendering the phrase as “*with reverence and awe*,” and Montgomery⁵ as “*with reverence and humility*.”

Paul’s usage of “*fear and trembling*” in II Corinthians 7:15 is quite telling.

And his [Titus] inward affection is more abundant toward you, whilst he remembereth the obedience of you all, how with fear and trembling ye received him (KJV).

Here is the question of learning: Were the Corinthian believers *afraid* of Titus to a point of *trembling* when he came to visit them? Or, as the context demonstrates, was their response toward him that which

brought him “comfort,” “joy” and “refreshment” (:7, 13)?

Were the Corinthians *afraid* of Titus, or did they *honor* and *respect* his coming to them?

We must always balance figures of speech with the truth plainly stated on any theme of Scripture. Thus, when contemplating “*fear and trembling*,” we must give way to the bold declaration that,

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love (I John 4:18, KJV).

J.B. Phillips (1906-1982), translator of the *New Testament in Modern English* (1958), wrote concerning his own struggles with the phrase “*fear and trembling*,”

I had for some time been worried about the expression “*fear and trembling*.” It did not seem likely to me that Paul in writing to the Philippians could have meant literally that they were to work out their salvation in a condition of anxiety and nervousness. We all know that fear destroys love and spoils relationships, and a great deal of the New Testament is taken up with getting rid of the old ideas of fear and substituting the new ideas of love and trust. I realized that the Greek word translated “*fear*” can equally well mean “*reverence*” or “*awe*” or even “*respect*,” but I was bothered about the “*trembling*.” Surely the same Spirit who inspired Paul to write to Timothy that “*God has not given us the spirit of fear; but of power and of love and of a sound mind*,” could not also have meant us to

live our entire lives in a state of nervous terror. I came to the conclusion, a little reluctantly, that the expression “*in fear and trembling*” had become a bit of a *cliché*,⁶ even as it has in some circles today. As I went on translating, I found that this must be the case. For when Paul wrote to the Corinthians and reported that Titus had been encouraged and refreshed by their reception of him, he then went on to say that the Corinthian[s] received him with “*fear and trembling*”! (II Corinthians 7:15). Now, this makes nonsense, unless it is a purely conventional verbal form implying proper “*respect*.” For, little as we know of Titus, we cannot imagine any real minister being encouraged and refreshed by a display of nervous anxiety.⁷ **BSN**

Thus, Phillips translated the verse as follows:

... *Work out the salvation that God has given you with a proper awe and responsibility* (Philippians 2:12, *New Testament in Modern English*).

The Mystery of Prayer

How clearly I can still hear those words from the lips of that dear lady! I was attending a YMCA meeting in my hometown. We had been assigned to groups of ten, with an adult advisor for each. One evening as we discussed the subject of prayer, our instructor burst into a heartbroken sob and told us not to get our hopes up too high because, “It just doesn’t work like the verse says it does.”



sion and bitterness are often the result.

The basic fallacy in modern-day prayer preaching and prayer practice comes from a failure to rightly divide the Word of Truth – the claiming of prayer promises that have *nothing* to do with the dispensation in which we live, but belong rather to a program which God Himself has interrupted and is temporarily holding in abeyance. The answer to the seeming mystery of prayer is the mystery revealed through the Apostle Paul.

The verse under consideration was Matthew 21:22:

And all things, what so ever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

What a heartbreak to see this woman – and there are thousands like her – crushed under the weight of claiming God’s Word by faith and then having it fail!

But what joy to be able to whisper into her ear the answer – that while Matthew 21:22 is indeed God’s Word, it was not God’s Word *to her*.

The vast majority of believers today have great inner fears about their prayers. They hear the exciting testimonies of ‘successful’ ‘prayer warriors’ who give illustration after illustration of personal triumphs in prayer. They hear – and they fear. For when they apply the offered ‘success formula’ it only confirms what their heart feared all along – it doesn’t work. Confu-

The prophetic program called for the blessings of God to go to the Gentiles through Israel, Abraham’s seed (Genesis 12:1-3; 22:17,18, etc.). When our Lord appeared He took up the theme of the prophets, proclaiming to Israel,

Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand (Matthew 4:17).

And going “*about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people* (Matthew 4:23; cf. 9:35, etc.).

All of this was a clear foretaste of the blessings of the Kingdom (see Isaiah 35; 33:24; Jeremiah 30:17, etc.). All this because, as Romans 15:8 says,

Jesus Christ was a minister of the Circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers.

The Twelve Apostles were trained and sent out to preach this same message (Matthew 10:1-8). After the resurrection, their ministry was enlarged (Mark 16:15, Luke 24:47, Acts 1:8), but not changed. Still the blessings were to go to the nations through Israel, Abraham's seed. Thus, Peter declares to them,

Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; and He shall send Jesus Christ, who before was preached unto you: ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, "And in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the Earth be blessed." Unto you first God, having raised up His son Jesus, sent Him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities (Acts 3:19-20, 25-26).

It is not until after the stoning of Stephen that the record gives any indication of a change in the established program. And how things do begin to change with the salvation of Saul of Tarsus! Our ascended Lord not only reached down and saved His chief enemy, but also made him His chosen vessel to carry a hitherto hidden message of grace to a rebellious world. Salvation – not through Israel's rise to Kingdom glory, but rather in spite of her rebellion, indeed, through her fall – was now to be sent to all alike (Romans 11:11,30-32). The prophetic program has been set aside for a time and the unprophesied dispensation of the grace of God has replaced it.

Today the Kingdom program is held in abeyance – temporarily suspended – while God is forming the Body of Christ. With this change in program, Israel and her program are set aside, replaced by the mystery committed to us through the ministry of Paul (Ephesians 3:1-9). Our ascended Lord gave to Paul – and through him to us – the very secret of His will, the purpose kept secret from before the foundation of the world!

As I Corinthians 2:7 declares,

We speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory.

What a glorious calling believers have today! What a shame to fail to appreciate it by failing to recognize and practice our standing in grace! Nowhere is this made clearer than where the subject of prayer is concerned. How a recognition of the mystery affects our prayer lives – and that for the good!

Rather than trying to force the Kingdom promise in Matthew 21:22 to work today, how much better it is to practice Romans 8:26-27!

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

Instead of wondering why John 14:13-14¹ does not "work" in our situation today, how much more

[To D.R.:] The highlight of Israel’s feasts were large, loud, lavish festivals where they were instructed to eat and drink “*whatsoever thy soul lusteth after*” (Deuteronomy 14:26)² – including “*wine*” and “*strong drink*.”³ There was “*singing with loud instruments*” (II Chronicles 30:21). Throughout Israel’s history there was loud singing, loud cymbals (Nehemiah 12:4; Psalm 150:5), and a general “*joyful noise*” (Isaiah 66:1; Psalm 81:1; 95:1-2; 98:4,6; 100:2), “*dance*” (Psalm 149:3; 150:4; Jeremiah 31:13; Ecclesiastes 3:4), and “*eating and drinking, and making merry*” (I Kings 4:20; Jeremiah 30:19; 31:4) In the parable of the “Prodigal Son,” when the older son came near the house, the celebration inside was so loud that he heard the “*music and dancing*” from the outside (Luke 15:25).

Prophecy in Hindsight

[Excerpt:] Several of David’s inspired songs operate on two levels. The first level describes the emotional weight of David’s own experience, whether good or bad, and the second level looks forward to David’s greater Son (Jesus) and what He would experience on earth during His life. We see a clear example of this in Psalm 22, where David’s experiences of suffering and persecution perfectly anticipate Christ’s crucifixion – even to the point where David says his foes pierced his hands and feet (:16).

A similar thing occurs in Psalm 16:8-11, which Peter quotes in Acts 2:25-28 as part of his Pentecost sermon. Peter said that David’s words anticipated the resurrection of Jesus. This is a marvelous picture of divine inspiration of the Scriptures. While David couldn’t have been aware of the future implications of his words, hindsight now makes their reality clear.
