Making the Point

A Poignant Illustration Regarding the Right Division of Paul's Epistles Part 1

nyone familiar with our teaching ministry knows that for over two decades we have stressed the importance of rightly dividing Paul's epistles. Since we first ran the article Rightly Dividing Paul's Epistles back in 1992, this crucial principle has been an underlying foundation of the *Bible Student's Notebook*.

Using only Paul's early ministry and epistles as our base, we will provide you with a poignant illustration demonstrating the need to rightly divide Paul's epistles.

We trust that the following imaginary example, based upon the facts of Scripture, will prove to assist our readers to see that Paul's earlier ministry and epistles were transitional in nature. If you do not currently see the need for such right division, then we trust that God will use this simple illustration to awaken you to think again.

"You were, in that era, apart from Christ, being alienated from the citizenship of Israel, and guests of the promise covenants, having no expectation, and without God in the world" (Ephesians 2:12, CV).

"Consequently, then, no longer are you guests and sojourners, but are fellow-citizens of the saints and belong to God's family" (Ephesians 2:19, CV).

The Greek word translated "guests" is ξένος (xenos) and means: foreign (literally alien ...) by implication, a guest (SEC). It is commonly translated "strangers" by other English versions.

A.E. Knoch wrote concerning this position as "guests,"

"... not until Paul's imprisonment that we were brought nigh and enter the family of God (Ephesians 2:18-19). Until then we were still guests at Israel's table, if not puppies under it." - Concordant Commentary on the New Testament (page 33)



Again, this is merely a fictional schedule for illustrative purposes. However, can you even imagine such respected teachers of the past failing to rightly divide Paul's epistles, and as a result having such a meeting?

Yet, why not? After all, this imaginary conference is firmly based on actual aspects of Paul's early ministry and epistles, is it not? Some would actually dare to suggest to us that Paul's epistles should *not* be rightly divided.¹⁶

16. Defending their need for modification, A.E. Knoch wrote:

In the transitional era preceding the present secret administration of God's transcendent riches of grace, Paul wrote his epistles to the Thessalonians and to the Romans, the Corinthians, the Galatians, as well as his first letter to Timothy. The question arises, did the revelation of the secret in Ephesians and its companion epistles annul the previous revelation completely, and ignore its recipients, so that Romans to Galatians and Thessalonians are obsolete, or do they still stand just as they are, so that Ephesians is a mere addition to their message?

Or is there a third course indicated, between these two extremes, their acceptance as a whole, yet with modifications in detail to accord with the later revelation? ...

All of Paul's previous epistles are definitely declared to be ours, yet with such modifications as the abrogation of Israel's priority involves. Ephesians does not restate Paul's previous evangel, for that would have been useless. All to whom the new revelation came were acquainted with it. All that they needed was the ability to adapt it to the larger light.

As a consequence, the epistle to the Ephesians is full of contacts

Did Paul somehow exempt his own epistles from "the Word of Truth" so that his decree to "rightly divide the Word of Truth" did not even include his writings?

Fast forward another six decades. What if this schedule was an advertisement for a conference held here in Windber, PA? Would you be shocked to see such a schedule? Would you even be able to believe your eyes? Would you even have any desire to attend such a meeting, unless perhaps it was for the mere purpose of witnessing such a spectacle? Yet some would venture even to suggest that Paul's epistles are somehow exempt from right division.


In the succeeding segments of this series we will take a closer look at the teaching material presented in these illustrative conference schedules. We will use the passages cited in the footnotes of this article to look more carefully at the nature of Paul's early epistles and ministry, and then demonstrate their striking contrast with his latter epistles and ministry.

and contrasts with Paul's previous teaching. Not only are we given the broad basis on which to build our attitude toward Paul's other writings, but many of the details are developed for us and the character of the link between the two is carefully considered.

 Unsearchable Riches Volume 18 (1927), pages 204-207 My heartfelt prayer for our readers is the same as that of our apostle:

I do not cease giving thanks for you, making mention in my prayers that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may be giving you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the realization of Him, the eyes of your heart having been enlightened, for you to perceive what is the expectation of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of the enjoyment of His allotment among the saints, and what the transcendent greatness of His power for us who are believing, in accord with the operation of the might of His strength, which is operative in the Christ, rousing Him from among the dead and seating Him at His right hand among the celestials, up over every sovereignty and authority and power and lordship, and every name that is named, not only in this eon, but also in that which is impending: and subjects all under His feet, and gives Him, as Head over all, to the ecclesia which is His body, the complement of the *One completing the all in all* (Ephesians 1:16-23).
