On Learning "New" Truth

previously believed differently about much of what I have learned and hold as current conviction of my faith. I have long seen that much of what I originally learned from the religious system is wrong, and I'm beginning to suspect that *all* of it is wrong.

I believe that much of what we think we know as "truth" has been imported into our thinking from entrenched religious dogma. Then, when confronted with something "new," we tend to object to the "new" information and strenuously defend what we've held to be "true," thereby rendering our minds to be closed to the new information. The result is that we actually fear anything different that threatens to displace our traditional beliefs. Dogmatic traditions erect remarkably resilient walls, sealed with the mortar of unalterable creedalism, and religious institutions are where most of these walls are found. It is this mentality that stagnates our perceived relationship with our Father, and wanes and weakens our faith.

Even teachers whom we highly esteem for their groundbreaking insights that challenged typical religious doctrines have been more or less susceptible to this pattern. Good examples are E.W. Bullinger's teaching about the conception/birth of Christ, and A.E. Knoch's teaching about the salvation of all and the purpose of evil. While these teachings "shook" my faith, even initially they rang true, and my conviction eventually changed. Yet, as I came to accept the "different" lessons of these wonderful teachers, I also came to recognize that no man is infallible – even these teachers who've opened my heart to precious "new" spiritual insights. They, too, while

having been brought to new understandings of traditional "truths," brought with them entrenched understandings of other doctrines which they didn't think would or could be changed, doctrines considered to be unchangeable and unchallengeable — and the same is true even for non-scholars such as myself.

This is true regarding my new understanding of *any* doctrine for which my conviction has changed: it is one more of the bricks of traditional religious dogma that is being removed by God's slow unveiling of His truth. This seems to be the way our Father works: He never gives us a full understanding all at once; but rather He slowly, gradually provokes our minds to open to "new" truths that eventually change our convictions, and thus our faith grows and strengthens. It always takes some time for me to arrive at any new conviction, but it is the result of reading and studying new information. I resist, but my heart genuinely and fervently desires to know Dad's Truth, and I trust that He will guide me into all of His truth, regardless of how long I perceive it to take.

I firmly believe now that religion in *any* form, and especially Christianity, has been the primary means for blinding men's minds. As we have learned that Satan (with his "*ministers*") is at the head of this

cabal of earthly deception (II Corinthians 11:13-15), it should come as no surprise that there is nothing that comes from it that could or should be considered beneficial, except for God's purpose of blinding the vast majority of mankind. This is not intended to consign this vast majority to a mythical eternal hell - all will eventually come to the full knowledge of truth – but for God to call out a comparatively few people in this current dispensation for the purpose of populating the Body of Christ and training them for their work in the Celestials at some point in our future of ministering the Gospel of God's salvation of all of His creation.

I believe that Dad knows our hearts best, and as we desire to know the truth, despite the cost to previously held convictions, He will lovingly and patiently gradually work in our hearts to bring us to the point of faith He desires us to have. It's all His work; it's all a part of the path He has designed for each of us. Furthermore, I believe it's o.k. to "resist" change, since I think that it's wise not to be "blown about with every wind of doctrine" (Ephesians 4:14); again, as Dad's will dictates, strong faith is tested and proven by strong winds – any weaknesses are blown away, with new understandings replacing them and fortifying what remains.

I no longer fear new information; God's truth needs no defense from me or anyone else. It is God Who gives the gift of faith (Ephesians 2:8), therefore it must also be His responsibility to ensure its growth and fruition (I Corinthians 3:6). I can read anything that is different from and challenges what I think I know is true; the difference is that I now approach it with an open mind and heart, trusting that, if it's true, then God will work in me to change my conviction about it. That's not to say that I don't have questions, but I've learned to be patient in waiting for Dad's work in me. There have been literally years between my initial exposure to a "new" doctrine and my ultimate acceptance of it. He certainly doesn't mind – He has all the time in the creation!

You'll note my copious use of the term "new" (with quote marks). I've done this to indicate that what we see as "new" information or doctrine was once considered to be the truth as held by the early church but became corrupted due to pagan/religious influence. It's only "new" to us today because we're seeing a difference from the "old" current/traditional dogma of the religious system. These "new" understandings today were once considered "new" in the early church with respect to the "old" teachings of the entrenched religious system of their day.

So, hang in there, my dear brothers and sisters, with patience, trusting the One Who only can change our hearts.





Commentary on Revelation - The Apoca-

lypse, or "The Day of the Lord"

by — E.W. Bullinger (1837-1913)

A dispensational approach to the Book of Revelation, this book is both practical and profound. Bullinger shares his insights in a compelling and clear manner. The theme of the book ("The Day of the Lord") is presented in this verse-by-verse study. "Our great fundamental proposition – which we may as well state at once – is that The Church is not the subject of the Apocalypse. However startling this may sound and may seem to some of our readers, we implore you not to dismiss it, but to test the reasons we shall give by the Word of God itself, and to weigh them in 'the balances of the sanctuary.' Try to forget all that you have 'received by tradition,' and ask from whom you learned this or that. Be prepared and ready to unlearn anything

that you may have received from men, and learn afresh from the Word of God itself." – E.W. Bullinger.

This is due to not knowing where else to put it.

The problem arises because there is conflicting information in Israel's prophecies regarding the Kingdom, a conflict which is settled by recognizing two very distinct segments of Israel's future Kingdom restoration: one *before* the Great Tribulation, the other *after*.

In other words, the missing element is that Israel will have their Kingdom restored to them PRIOR to the Great Tribulation and the Second Advent. This is the Pre-Tribulational segment of Israel's future Kingdom.³

This Kingdom will have David as King;⁴ the Temple rebuilt;⁵ and animal sacrifices restored.⁶

Prior to the Pre-Tribulational phase⁷ of the *Kingdom of Heaven*, Christ will make His appearance in the Celestials, and the members of His Body will make a joint-de-

At the end of this Pre-Tribulational portion of Israel's Kingdom, another great national testing resulting in apostasy will take place: "a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed" (II Thessalonians 2:3). This man of sin will sit in the "temple of God" that was built during this prior (Pre-Tribulational) Kingdom stage.

The Pre-Tribulational Kingdom will be "The Day of Christ," while the Millennial Kingdom will be "The Day of the Lord."

The simple chart above may assist in grasping the concept.

This may be quite a paradigm shift for some dispensational students of Scripture. Fully appreciating this concept may require significant thought and study.

In this and upcoming issues of the *Bible Student's Notebook*, we will begin to slowly develop the many aspects of this theme.


