Christ and His Body: Ministry According to the “Administration of the Secret”

by — John Robert Caldwell (1839-1917)

The epistle to the Ephesians is the book in which the Spirit of God unfolds that which is called “the Secret.” Its first mention is in 1:9, and it is here called “the Secret of His will.” It was “purposed in Himself;” it dates from “before the foundation of the world” (:4). It was God’s own conception in sovereignty and grace “according to His good pleasure,” and involves the ultimate “gathering together” or heading up of “all things in Christ” (:10).



the Spirit to Israel nationally had been given.

ITS REVELATION

The revelation specially communicated by the Lord Jesus to His apostle Paul is thus described:

That the Gentiles should be fellow-heirs, and of the same body and partakers of His promise in Christ by the Gospel (Ephesians 3:6).

A “secret” in its Scripture sense is not, as it is usually understood, something that is incomprehensible, but is rather something up to a certain point unrevealed; a secret not divulged.

From the beginning of the ages THIS “Secret” had been kept “hid in God” (3:9). It is spoken of in language that warrants our saying that it is of all His purposes the highest and most stupendous display of wisdom, power, and love.

To the Ephesians he writes in order that they might understand his “knowledge in the secret of Christ.” It must have struck them as very surprising that Paul should have knowledge of the counsels of God beyond that given to any other apostle. Hence the necessity that Paul should inform them of the fact that the Lord made it known to him “by revelation.” It was a “dispensation of the grace of God” given to him specially for them – Gentiles. The truth of “the Secret” was not to be published until the final testimony of

The expression “in Christ” is that which gives its character to the revelation. It occurs more frequently in this epistle than in any other.

That Gentiles should be brought into blessing in connection with Israel is abundantly foretold in the Old Testament. Such Scriptures are repeatedly referred to as showing the purpose of God that the gospel should not be limited in its proclamation to Israel (see Acts 15:16-17; 13:47; Romans 15:8-12, 21), as at first it really was (see Acts 11:19).

That the reign of Christ not only would restore Israel, but “all nations” would be richly blessed both in spiritual and temporal things, is the common testimony

of the prophets. However, such blessing to Gentiles is always *through* Israel, and in subordination to Israel, and recognizes Jerusalem, “*the city of the great King*” as the center, the metropolis, of the Kingdom.

“IN CHRIST”

What had not been revealed was that both Jews and Gentiles should form “One Body” and be partakers of all of the promises of God “*in Christ*.” It is not that they should be made joyful under Messiah’s rule, or enter into the millennial glory of His Kingdom – which, glorious as it is, falls immeasurably short of the portion of those, be they Jew or Gentile as to the flesh, who are “*in Christ*.”

“*In Christ*” the believer is “*blessed with all spiritual blessings in the heavenlies*” (Ephesians 1:3). “*In Christ Jesus*” he is “*made nigh by His Blood*” (2:13).

In Him he has “*obtained an inheritance*” (1:11). In Him also he is “*sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise which is the earnest of our inheritance*” (Ephesians 1:13-14). He is not only quickened (2:5) and raised up together with Christ, but is also, according to

God’s reckoning, “*made to sit together in the heavenlies in Him*” (2:6). In that elect, redeemed, quickened, blood-sealed company who are “*in Christ*,”

There is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all (Colossians 3:11).

“ONE BODY”

This oneness with Christ is peculiarly and appropriately expressed in the figure of the human body, head, and members. The relationship of Old Testament believers is not so set forth; neither is this figure used by any other of the New Testament writers than Paul. It is inseparably connected with the secret as specially revealed to Paul, and the truths that are associated with it.

True science acknowledges with one consent that the human body is the masterpiece of the material creation so far as known to us. The delicacy of its construction, the multitude, variety and adaptation of its parts, each for its own purpose, the sympathetic mu-

tual dependence that pervades the whole, the presiding authority of the head over all the members and the communication of all sensation, even from the feeblest member to the brain, all serve to make it a divinely suitable figure to represent the oneness of Christ and His Body.

ITS ADMINISTRATION

There occurs in Ephesians 3:9 an expression which has been almost wholly overlooked, but to which it would be well to give most earnest and diligent heed:

To make all men see what is the dispensation of the secret.

The *Authorized Version* here uses the word “*fellowship*.” It is set aside as incorrect by all of the best authorities, and the word “*dispensation*” used as in the *Revised Version*. Dispensation is the same word as “*stewardship*.” A steward is one who *administers* the affairs of another. Hence, probably the most appropriate word to give the sense would be “*the administration of the Secret*.”

THE UNITY OF THE SPIRIT

Ecclesiastical unity and “*the unity of the Spirit*” are two distinct things, so much so that the former may be directly opposed to the latter.

To limit the scope of this to the “*two or three*” who may be gathered in one place, or to any number of associated meetings, or to those gathered upon any particular principle, or to anything short of the entire Body of which Christ is the Head, is to miss the Spirit's teaching and to surrender the essential char-

acteristic of the dispensation, *viz.*, the oneness of all in Christ.

A LIVING ORGANISM

The Body is a living organism indwelt and energized by the Spirit of God. As every member of the human body is vitalized by one spirit, exercises its own function, and is subject to one directing and controlling head, so is the Body of Christ.


Christ, from whom the whole Body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplies, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, makes increase of the Body unto the edifying of itself in love (Ephesians 4:15-16).

Not holding the head, from whom all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increases with the increase of God (Colossians 2:19).

The fitness of each joint and band, of each member, be it great or small, powerful or feeble, to fulfil its own function depends upon the qualifying and energizing of God's Spirit. Such is the Divine principle appointed of God for the edification of the Body of Christ.

A WORD ON THE ORIGIN OF CLERISY

The flesh is always restless, thus originated the clerical system. Men found it irksome to wait upon such ministry as the Spirit imparted through the members of Christ's Body. Out of impatience and a lack of readiness for spiritual service, there sprang up the desire for men who would take the responsibility of

ministry, who would be duly qualified according to human ideas for the service, who should devote their whole time to it, and who should be paid a sufficient salary for the work. Such men soon ceased to be the servants of Christ and became the servants of men.

Such “ministry” would relieve the members of Christ’s Body of the responsibility of their true ministry one to another. From such a carnal system, what began as *ministry* merged into *priesthood*, and only through this order of men could ministry then be carried out.

Wherever such a system be found, be it in Rome or in the most evangelical Nonconformist denomination, the Spirit is necessarily quenched in His manifestations, and the “*Administration of the Secret*” according to God is impeded. Ministry degenerates for the most part into what is purely formal, a priest performing divine service on behalf of the people, while true spiritual ministry is effectually set aside.

An assemblage is present, composed of believers and unbelievers mixed together; they are there to hear a sermon, to which everything else is quite subordinate. “Ministry” is conducted by the one man, and others are relieved of their responsibility to minister what God has given to them.

The functions of the whole Body are assumed by one, and all the rest through lack of exercise, if not also through lack of nourishment, become functionally paralyzed.

That many such “ministers” are spiritually-minded

men and servants of Christ, we thankfully acknowledge. The concern is not about *persons* but about *principles*. With all respect for such men, we cannot but assert that their monopolizing “ministries” should be the responsibility of each member according to its own function, and that this is utterly at variance with the truth of the “*Administration of the Secret*.” Such professional ministry denies the Spirit’s rightful place over ministry and abolishes the responsibility that rests on every member of Christ’s Body, be it ever so feeble, to impart something toward the edification of the whole.

Human ordination and education have given the clergyman his privileged status, which the most experienced and spiritual believer cannot attain. The whole system is essentially opposed to “*the Administration of the Secret*.” **BSN**



In past issues of the *Bible Student’s Notebook* we have dealt with the subject of the *Three Spheres of Glory*. The initial five articles were compiled into book form under the same title.¹ Since that time we ran two additional articles² and have dealt with questions for clarification that have arisen.³ The chart above and this summary article are further attempts to bring conciseness and clarity to this important theme.



Some will be the “sand” seed of Abraham, some his “star” seed, others have their calling in Christ before the disruption of the cosmos.⁴

THE FIRST SPHERE

The first sphere of hope is the Earth. It is the realization of the expanded dominion of Eden’s garden of paradise. It is the baseline glory for which all of creation has a premonition.

In these future spheres of glory some will inherit the Earth, some will live in the New Jerusalem, and others will be seated with Christ, far above all principalities and powers, reigning with Him in the Super-Heavens.

Some will be the citizens of the Kingdom of Heaven on the Earth; some will make up the Bride, the Lamb’s wife; while others are members of Christ’s Body, reigning among the Celestials.

The “meek” among Israel and the Nations will “inherit the Earth” (Matthew 5:5). They will be given an earthly allotment as their glory. These are Abraham’s “dust” and “sand” seed (Genesis 13:16; Genesis 22:17; Hebrews 11:12).

Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth (Matthew 5:5).

Happy are the meek, for they shall be enjoying the allotment of the land (CV).

These are all those who were “just”⁵ in their dealings with others.

The just judgment of God, Who will be paying each one in accord with his acts: to those, indeed, who by endurance in good acts are seeking glory and honor and incorruption, life eonian (Romans 2:6-7).

The Earth is Israel’s sphere according to the flesh (Romans 9:3-5) and will include the Gentile nations that pass the Judgment of the Nations.⁶

He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the Earth (Psalm 72:8).

I shall give Thee the heathen for Thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the Earth for Thy possession (Psalm 2:8).

He shall speak peace unto the heathen: and His dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the Earth (Zechariah 9:10).

The Earth will be a colony of the Heavens. Its divine rule will be the “Kingdom of the Heavens” with Israel ruling over Earth’s inhabitants.

Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done in Earth, as it is in Heaven (Matthew 6:10).

THE SECOND SPHERE

The heavenly sphere of the New Jerusalem “descending out of Heaven from God” (Revelation 3:12; 21:2, 10), is for all of those who are “of the faith of Abraham” (Romans 4:16) – those who are “Abraham’s seed, heirs according to the promise” (Galatians 3:29). These are those who among Israel and the Nations who have their “calling” of hope prior to Acts 28.

This second-sphere election makes them “partakers of a heavenly calling” (Hebrews 3:1).⁷ Like their spiritual father, Abraham, they “looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God” (Hebrews 11:10).

The City of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem ... the church of the firstborn, which are written in Heaven (Hebrews 12:22-23).

The New Jerusalem will be the administrative capital of Israel’s world-wide Kingdom on Earth.

And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the Earth unto Jerusalem to worship the King, the Lord of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain (Zechariah 14:16-17).

This is the sphere of Abraham's *spiritual* seed, which included believing Gentiles during the Acts period.

And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise (Galatians 3:29).⁸

Unlike the "meek" and "good" among Israel and the Nations who will "inherit the Earth" (Matthew 5:5), these have been granted the faith of their father, Abraham, and have become destined to be his second-sphere "star" seed, contrasted with his first-sphere "dust" and "sand" seed (cf. Genesis 15:5; 22:17; Hebrews 11:12).

These second-sphere "star" seeds make up "the Bride, the Lamb's Wife" (Revelation 21:9). They are God's called-out-ones who had a fixed hope before the current Secret Administration. They were the believers who were represented by "the ecclesia in the wilderness" (Acts 7:38), those built upon the confession of Christ's Messiahship ("upon this rock will I build My

ecclesia," Matthew 16:18), whose number were added to on a daily basis during the Acts Period (Acts 2:46-47), and which Saul relentlessly persecuted ("persecuted the ecclesia of God," I Corinthians 15:9; Galatians 1:13). These are those "called" who will be citizens of that heavenly city coming out of Heaven to the Earth.

The city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which is descending out of Heaven from My God ...

The Bride, the Lamb's wife ... the holy Jerusalem (Revelation 3:12; 21:9-10).

While Israel rules over the Earth, the Twelve and the rest of the Bride will rule over Israel from the New Jerusalem.

THE THIRD SPHERE

The third sphere is the unique calling of the One Body "among the Celestials." The revelation of this pinnacle sphere is found only in the letters of Ephesians and Colossians. This phrase, "among the Celestials," is exclusive to the book of Ephesians (1:3, 20; 2:6; 3:10; 6:12, CV). These two epistles unveil the *Secret Administration* (Ephesians 3:9) and its sphere of glory "far above all Heavens" (Ephesians 4:10) where Christ sits "in Glory" (Colossians 3:4) "at the right hand of God" (:1), and where we will one day "appear with Him" (:4).

"The administration of God which is given to [Paul] for [us]" makes "Christ in [us], the hope of Glory" (Colossians 1:25-27).

The Lord Jesus Christ has been given "ALL authority, in Heaven and on Earth" (Matthew 28:18, REB). His Body will have jurisdiction over all spheres.

Out of Him, and through Him, and to Him, are ALL things (Romans 11:36).

God is the beginning of “all,” and He surely will be the consummation of “all.” This is the divine goal:

That God will be All in all (I Corinthians 15:28, DT).

In other words, God will be “Everything *in* everything” and “Everything *to* Everyone.” His entire creation – without exception – will be gloriously complete and in perfect harmony with Himself; all that there is, ever was and ever will be, coming out of, operating through and returning to Him. **BSN**

What a grand conclusion!


