Everything comes from Him;

All comes from Him, all lives by Him, all ends in Him (MNT)

Here is the simple, glorious truth of Romans 11:36 in a nutshell:

- (1) All is *out of* God.
- (2) All is *through* God.
- (3) All is *to* God.



ans 5:18, CV).

The One Who is operating all in accord with the counsel of His will (Ephesians 1:11, CV).

A.E. Knoch (1874-1965) skillfully summarized the core truths of Romans 11:36.

The knowledge that “all” comes “out” of God, that “all” operates “through” God, and that “all” is returning “to” God settles the weary heart and brings peace to the troubled mind.

Romans 11:36 is the *Divine Cycle*¹ and is a bedrock truth often repeated by Paul, our Apostle:

One God, the Father, out of Whom all is (I Corinthians 8:6, CV).

All is of God (I Corinthians 11:12; II Corinthi-

This is the most comprehensive statement which can be uttered. The universe sprang out of Him and it has its course in Him, and He will be its ultimate. This settles all speculation as to the origin of all things. Creation is out of God, not out of nothing. This explains universal history. God is the One back of all the movements of mankind. This reveals the goal of all things. God is so guid-

ing all His creatures that, eventually, He will become their All.²

THREE PREPOSITIONS OF SOVEREIGNTY

In Romans 11:36 Paul reveals to us the three prepositions of God's absolute sovereignty:

ἐκ — διὰ — εἰς
out of — through — to

ἐκ (*ek*) – “out of” – is defined as:

A primary preposition denoting *origin* (the point whence motion or action proceeds), *from*, *out* (*SEC*).

διὰ (*dia*) – “through” – is defined as:

A primary preposition denoting the *channel* of an act; *through* (*SEC*).

εἰς (*eis*) – “to” – is defined as:

A primary preposition; *to* or *into* (indicating the point reached or entered), of place, time, or purpose (*SEC*).

Thus, that “all” is “out of God” speaks of *ORIGIN*; that “all” is “through God” speaks of the *CHANNEL*; and that “all” is “to God” speaks of *CONSUMMATION*.

We will look briefly at each of these three areas, giving them some thoughtful consideration in order to gain a foundation for divine orientation.

All things are from Him (TCNT).

From Him everything comes (WNT).

From Him are all things (HCSB).

All comes from Him (MNT).

From Him their Source flow all things (WAY)

God is Elohim, meaning that He is the ORIGINATOR of “all.”

In the beginning God Elohim created ... (Genesis 1:1).

Since there was once nothing but God, then of course “all” is “out of Him.” He created the entire Universe and everything in it out of Himself. Everything is out of Him.³

That *all is out of God* is the first principle. We must learn this first if we will truly learn anything else of true substance. We must start our doctrine with *God*, for He is the *source* of everything.

If God is not the starting place of our understanding, and we instead begin with ourselves, we will end up humanistic and evolutionary; we will be man-centered and world-conscious, placing our focus on the relative aspect of life.

3. That *all is out of God* is to be distinguished from the idea that God created “everything out of nothing.” This concept of “out of nothing” leaves room for God to have a mere superficial, passing interest in His creation. However, creation is much more personal to God than that – it is *all out of Him*. The difference is between that of mere Artisan and that of Father. He is the “one God and Father of all, Who is above all, and through all, and in you all” (Ephesians 4:6), “for in Him we live, and move, and have our being ... for we are also His offspring” (Acts 17:28). That *all is out of God* means that makes all of creation an essential part of His Being. To fully understand and embrace this truth is to find unparalleled comfort and peace.

If, however, our starting place is with God we will be God-centered and God-conscious, having our focus firmly anchored in the absolute⁴ aspect of life.

Some have no trouble with everything coming out of God, if it is restricted to His initial creation – the moon, the stars, the world, etc. – but when they get past that initial creation they quickly become humanistic and evolutionary in their thinking. To them “all” is out of God in creation, but quickly things change and now somehow all comes out of man.

To emphasize the truth of Romans 11:36 more pointedly, let us misquote it:

Out of Him, and through Him, and to Him are some things.³

Yet the verse does not end with “some things,” but “all things” – therefore, absolutely nothing is excluded from God’s design and purpose.

The Greek word for “God” is *Theos*, meaning that He is the PLACER; while the Hebrew word for “God” is *El*, meaning that He is the SUBJECTOR. What this means is that God has placed “*all things*” where they are in His creation, and He has subjected them to the conditions and circumstances in which they find themselves. “*All*” have their course in God; He is behind all of the circumstances and movements of His creation.

“*All things*” are right where God placed them (for He is *Theos*, the PLACER); “*all things*” are subject to the conditions in which they find themselves (for He is *El*, the SUBJECTOR); and “*all things*” remain subjected where they are until He places them elsewhere.

“*All*” is not just “*out of Him*,” nor is “*all*” simply “*through Him*,” but “*all*” is also assuredly on a journey back “*to Him*” as well. This speaks to the *destination of everything* – to its *divine conclusion*.

It is a deep reality, as will be seen in the literal rendering of the original, which reads “*all is into Him*” (Romans 11:36). — M. Jaegle

Observe how translations render this final truth of Romans 11:36.

Everything ends up in Him (MSG).

All ends in Him (MNT).

In Him everything ends (GNT).

To Him, their consummation (WAY).

Herein lies the grand truth that “*all*” of God’s creation will be reconciled back to Himself – “*all ... in Earth*” and “*all ... in Heaven*” (Colossians 1:20). God will leave no corner of His vast and wonderful universe outside of His unfailing love.

*That in the dispensation of the fullness of times
He might gather together in One **all things** in*

*Christ, both which are in **Heaven**, and which are on **Earth**; even in Him* (Ephesians 1:10).

*That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in **Heaven**, and things in **Earth**, and things under the Earth; and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father* (Philippians 2:10- 11).

This reconciliation is truly total and universal! No part of God’s creation will be left out. Nothing will be left alienated or *unreconciled* to God. *All* will return to remain always in complete harmony with its Source. There will be an entire, universal “*restoration of all things*,”

... that God may be All in all [i.e., everything to everyone] (I Corinthians 15:21-28).

Don’t be discouraged when you look around you. What you see is not the end of God’s plan and purpose. What you see is not the finished product of God. You are not now observing the destination, but only a very small part of the journey *toward* the destination. God is actively at work in His entire creation, and in every circumstance, with the sure goal of masterfully *bringing all things*, in complete fulfillment, back to Himself.

Romans 11:36 is a foundational gateway to divine orientation. A true understanding of the truth of this verse will facilitate a spiritual disposition toward God and toward all of His creation, as well as all of the circumstances of life – all of them, without one single exception.

Thus, the *Divine Cycle* begins with God, operates completely through God, and ends perfectly back to and in God.

For out of Him, and through Him, and to Him are all: to Whom be glory for the ages. Amen (BSV). **BSN**

Christ, Our Glorious Expectation

Christ in you, the hope of glory (Colossians 1:27).

Christ among you, the expectation of glory (CV).

In these words there lies an untold wealth of deepest meaning for the saints of God. They set forth a secret unfolded for rich individual blessing.

While Israel is set aside (they must know a long and weary waiting period), Christ, now at the right hand of God, ministers from the Heavens a rare grace among the nations. His words on Earth were those of grace and truth, but how much more so, His words from the Heavens.

Because God is now silent, men think of Him as being altogether outside the affairs of life. To many minds it appears a long, long silence – an interval of sheer frustration. This is because they are disposed to things on the Earth. They fail to realize the character of the life “*hid together with Christ in God.*”

Be disposed to that which is above, not to that on the Earth, for you died, and your life is hid together with Christ in God (Colossians 3:2-3).

Silence, yes; but the interlude is indeed a full one of God’s rich grace, of His previously unseen and unheard advances. Our supreme concern is with the glorious expectation so inseparably linked with our

celestial allotment. Its outstanding feature is that we are “*in a state of prior expectancy in the Christ*” (Ephesians 1:12, CV, 1930). **BSN**



Reader's Question Box #54

“Cut Off”

by — Clyde L. Pilkington, Jr.

Q: What will happen to the Gentiles when they are “cut off” in that age or this age. I understand that in the age to come all will be restored. There are so many theologians that are hung up on just a handful of verses, and Gentiles being “cut off” is one of them. Thank you for your help. – *T.P.*

A: “Cut off” is a reference to divine judgment, specifically that of “premature” death (cf. Genesis 9:11; Exodus 9:15; Psalm 37:9; Isaiah 53:8; Lamentations 3:53; Obadiah 1:9-10; Ezekiel 13:8). Its “premature” nature is relative, not absolute.¹ Such *cutting off* was a constant danger during previous Jewish administrations.

Romans 11:22 is a reference to the Gentiles who, during the Acts Administration, had been “grafted in among” the Jews (the “natural branches,” :21) and who were made *partakers* of Israel’s “root and fatness” (:17). They were instructed to “*be not highminded, but fear*” (:20) lest they be “cut off” like the natural branches.


Throughout the Old Testament, Gospels and Acts Period,² while Israel was still the nation of God, Jews,

as well as Gentiles grafted in among them, could be “cut off” from the land of the living – that is, they could sin a sin “worthy of death” (Deuteronomy 17:6). This is what the Circumcision Apostle, John, referred to as “*a sin unto death*” (I John 5:16). The Israelites Ananias and Sapphira were “cut off” by such a divine judgment in Acts 5. Paul, during the Acts Period,³ while acting as a priest⁴ of (see *RQB #54*, page 7128)

Our Hope Upon the Heavens

Whereof I am made a minister according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfill the word of God. Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to His saints. To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory (Colossians 1:25-27).

Paul was made a steward over God's program for today. This dispensation, given to Paul, completes and fulfills the Word of God. Each age has had its own direction by God as to how He governs mankind. Paul was given the final plan needed to complete the Word of God. No knowledge of a Hope upon¹ the Heavens was ever known to mankind before it was revealed to Paul.



Israel to the Gentiles, warned them concerning being "cut off" (Romans 11:22; cf. I Corinthians 5:5; 11:30; Galatians 5:12).

However, no such danger exists now during the Secret Administration⁵ of Ephesians and Colossians. This is because no one today has been grafted into such a relationship with Israel, and therefore are not in any possibility of being "cut off" from a living union with Israel's dispensational advantages. In fact, today Israel

has no such dispensational advantages whatsoever, because they have been "lo-ammi" ("not My people")⁶ since the close of the book of Acts. Those who believe today, rather than being grafted into Israel's blessings, make up "the one new man" of Ephesians 2. This is a new, previously unrevealed entity that stands completely apart from Israel – having its own unique, heavenly calling and destiny.⁷ **BSN**

now Christ is sent to the nations. From the Greek Colossians 1:27 can be translated, "Christ among you, the hope of glory."²
