### *I Misunderstood that 7-Millennialism was but a Human Theory*



#### **I IGNORED "A THOUSAND GENERATIONS"**

While accepting traditional 7-Millennialism, I also ignored that multiplied millennia remain, even more than have yet transpired, for the fulfillment of

all of the glorious plans of the ages that God has revealed in His Word.

Far from us being anywhere near the "end" of something prophetic, the span of God's plan of the ages is immense, and our placement in the Secret Administration is early on its timeline. Much more of God's prophetic program remains than man's feeble eschatologies allow.

I would come to see that the remaining time for unfulfilled prophecy is some 20,000 years or more.

Carefully notice God's specific, often repeated promise of "a thousand generations" found in the following verses:

*Showing faithful love to a thousand generations of those who love Me and keep My commandments (Exodus 20:6, HCSB).*

*Keeping lovingkindness to a thousand generations, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin ... (Exodus 34:7, YLT).*

*Showing lovingkindness unto a thousand generations unto them who love Me, and keep My commandments (Deuteronomy 5:10, REB).

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Know therefore that the Lord your God, He is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments **to a thousand generations** (Deuteronomy 7:9).

Be mindful always of His covenant; the word which He commanded **to a thousand generations** (I Chronicles 16:15).

He has remembered, unto **times age-abiding**, His covenant, the word He commanded, **to a thousand generations** (Psalm 105:8, REB).

Thou exercise kindness unto **the thousandth generation** ... (Jeremiah 32:18, Leeser Translation, 1853).

A generational cycle is the period from the birth of one generation to the birth of the next. If the lower end of a generational cycle were 20 years,<sup>1</sup> God's prophetic fulfillment with Israel would be 20,000 years. However, if it would be on the higher end of the scale, this period would be upwards of some 50,000 years.<sup>2</sup>

Thus, I would learn that it is essential to understand that Israel's unfulfilled prophecies will be brought to pass over a *very long period* of time – at least 20,000 years, or possibly more.

Even considering the most conservative period of 20,000 years, here is a sample breakdown of the remainder of the prophetic ages:

#### Phase 1:

##### ◆ *The Pre-Millennial Kingdom*

Perhaps encompassing some 500 years or more.

#### Phase 2:

##### ◆ *The Millennial Kingdom*

1000 years.

#### Phase 3

##### ◆ *The New Heaven & Earth Kingdom*

18,500 years or more.

While some start this thousand-generation fulfillment with Adam<sup>3</sup> or Abraham,<sup>4</sup> others<sup>5</sup> (such as ourselves) see that this entire period more likely remains to be yet future.

So, once the Secret Administration has run its Divinely designated course, as much as 50,000 prophet-

ic years remain.

However, regardless of the actual duration, here is what some diligent students of the Scriptures have written concerning these many prophetic millennia yet to be fulfilled.

#### George L. Rogers (1869-1947)

Many generations are yet to come. Israel's future place in the new earth is indicated by the fact that God's covenant with them is to a thousand generations.<sup>6</sup>

#### Clarence Larkin (1850-1924)

As the duration of God's Covenant with Israel was extended in Deuteronomy 7:9 to "a thousand generations," or 33,000 years, we have an intimation that the "Dispensation of the Fulness of Times" [Ephesians 1:10] will last for at least that length of time.<sup>7</sup>

#### George F. Trench (1841-1915)

We find in Deuteronomy 7:9 and I Chronicles 16:15 an indirect, but not unimportant, confirmation of our forecast, where the duration of the covenant of God with Israel is extended, not merely to a thousand years, but to "a thousand generations" – a truly glorious revelation of Israel's future in the Age of the new creation.<sup>8</sup>

#### A.E. Knoch (1874-1965)

The Kingdom of Christ will bring in righteousness for a thousand years, but the throne of the Son will assure reconciliation of a thousand generations.<sup>9</sup>

#### Adlai Loudy (1893-1984)

We have every reason to think that the succeeding eon will be very much longer. Considerations based upon the "thousand generations" of the Psalmist and the grand cycles of the Heavens, suggest that the last eon will be at least seventeen thousand years in length.<sup>10</sup>

... to Him be glory in the ecclesia and in Christ Jesus for all the **generations** of the eon of the eons! (Ephesians 3:21).

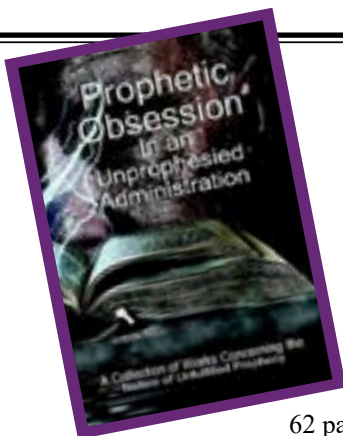
Here we are informed that in the last eon of glory there will be *generations*. The nations in the New Earth, the paradise of God, will continue to multiply. And in that new creation when the abiding glory of God will replace the temporary luminaries – the sun, moon and stars – of the old creation, time will be marked by *generations*.<sup>11</sup>

How many generations will there be? Some idea of the number will enable us to form a rough estimate of its length. The psalmist speaks of a thousand generations (Psalm 105:8). I know of no good reason why this should not be taken literally.

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The length of a generation is not easy to determine, neither is it vital. It could hardly average under twenty years. ...

I have sometimes wondered if the eons are measured by that long astronomical cycle of nearly twenty-six thousand years which is formed by the sun as it shifts its place in crossing the ecliptic, making what is called the precession of the equinoxes. At one time the sun's annual crossing of the ecliptic in the spring of the year, making day and night of equal length, occurred in the sign of Virgo. Now it is in Aries. At the end of the cycle it will be in Leo. It leads from the Virgin to the Lion out of Judah's tribe. All of the symbolism seems to fit this notion. Even the thousand generations may find a place in this speculation. I do not rely upon it. But these figures leave little doubt that the last eon will be an enormously prolonged period of time. ...

The point we wish to press is this, that by far the greater part of mankind in the eons are found in the last of the series.<sup>12</sup>

## I IGNORED THE SECRET ADMINISTRATION

As my studies over the decades would progress, I would come to see that my 7-Millennialism had ignored our current administration.

ness of times" (Ephesians 1:10), that KINGDOM of the Son of God's love, that KINGDOM that cannot be shaken, which it is Christ's to enjoy as Heir of all things, and Head of the new creation. George F. Trench was an associate of Dr. E.W. Bullinger.

Throughout Scripture we are presented with various administrations.<sup>13</sup> These administrations, sometimes called "dispensations," or "economies," are divine managements, or stewardships. They are the organization and implementation of specific divine purposes. There are seven basic administrations.

The present Secret Administration<sup>14</sup> was "hid in God" (Ephesians 3:9), "hid from the ages and generations" (Colossians 1:25-26). It unveils "the unsearchable"<sup>15</sup> riches of Christ" (Ephesians 3:8) not found elsewhere in Scripture. It involves "The Dispensation of the Grace of God" (Ephesians 3:2),<sup>16</sup> a despotism<sup>17</sup> of

## *After the Thousand Years: The Glorious Reign of Christ as Son of Man in the Dispensation of the Fullness of Times*

by — George F. Trench (1841-1915)

In Revelation 20 the closing period of the Millennium is foretold as one of general insurrection against Christ as King, thus revealing the true condition of the population of the world, taken as a whole, throughout the thousand years. A Kingdom such as this cannot be the KINGDOM described in the epistles of Paul. According to I Corinthians 15:24, our Lord will not reign forever, but will deliver up His mediatorial KINGDOM to God at its end, that God will henceforth be "All in all." If the reign of Christ in its perfection cannot be millennial, and shall not be eternal, it follows that between the end of the one, the millennial, and the beginning of the other, the eternal state, must of necessity intervene that "dispensation of the full-

grace, committed only to Paul, not associated with any covenant, new or old (Ephesians 2:14-15; Colossians 2:14), nor to human merit or rules (Colossians 2:8), ordinances, holy days, etc. (Colossians 2:16).

All things emphasized in the past under Israel's administrations (Promise, Law and Pentecost) have been removed. We now live under an administration where the *Barrier Wall*<sup>18</sup> has been removed (cf. Ephesians 2:14, CV), and in the absence of that wall, we are "complete in Him" (Colossians 2:10). There is nothing that needs to be added.

Believers of this present Secret Administration are a "Joint-Body" (Ephesians 3:6), called the "One New Man" (:15), and share Christ's Universal Headship inherent in the Heavens (4:15-16; Colossians 1:16-19; 2:10).

Because the current administration was an absolute secret, it is not the subject of prophecy. What this means is that Israel is currently in abeyance (Lo-am-

mi – "Not My People" Hosea 1:9<sup>19</sup>), and her prophetic clock has now stopped,<sup>20</sup> resulting in any prophetic timetable being paused for the past two millennia. This being the case, any such supposed week of seven millennia, even if it were true, would currently be stopped as well. (We will look more closely at the impact that the Secret Administration has on prophecy in our next lesson.)

## I IGNORED "THE KINGDOM OF THE HEAVENS"

While espousing 7-Millennialism I also ignored the next prophetic period that was to come, after the close of the Secret Administration. By a failure to "distinguish between things that differ" (Philippians 1:20, MKJV)<sup>21</sup> my study of prophecy entirely ignored the importance and distinction of "the Day of

When reading the Scriptures, it is vitally important that you ask yourself the simple question: "Is the middle wall of partition up, or is it down?" Recognizing and answering this crucial question is an important key in following Paul's instruction found in II Timothy 2:15 of "rightly dividing" (KJV), "correctly cutting" (CV, 1976 – 6<sup>th</sup> Edition) or "correctly partitioning" (CV, 1927 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition) the "Word of truth." It's not until you get to the pinnacle writings of Paul – Ephesians and Colossians – that you see this barrier removed. Read these letters that reveal the Secret Administration and enjoy God's truth for today.

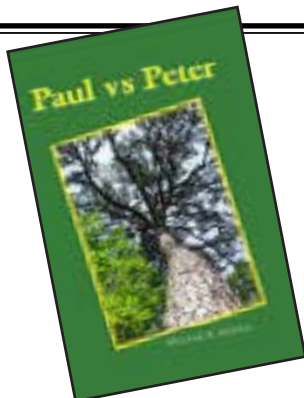

It was very hard for me even to consider “the Day of Christ,” as such a period of prophetic time would have truly wreaked havoc on my imagined week of one-thousand-year days.

Yet, over a prolonged time I would ever so gradually be freed from the restraints of this manmade concept, so as to embrace many profound truths, once completely hidden from me, of which I now have come to truly rejoice.
